Farm Pointers

Oregon pear growers are learning the value of early picking to prevent roe breakdown. Use of the pressure tester developed by the experiment station to tell the right time for harvesting is growing. Only the pears picked after the best picking time had passed became affected in the observations conducted by the station.

Occasionally land that produced a grain crop in Oregon is successfully disked and sowed to common vetch, the experiment station reports. Only on land of good fifth and free from weeds, and in the fall, can this be done successfully. It is usually a poor practice, as under average conditions the ground is hard, often weedy, and hard to get into good seed bed shape.

Weak or diseased potato plants are usually unproductive and incurable, the O. A. C. experiment station reports. Hence they should be eradicated. In the frequent field inspections by the growers, the plants showing a weak or unhealthy look are best dug out, seed piece and all, and taken at once from the field before the trouble spreads to other plants.

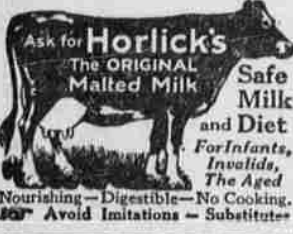
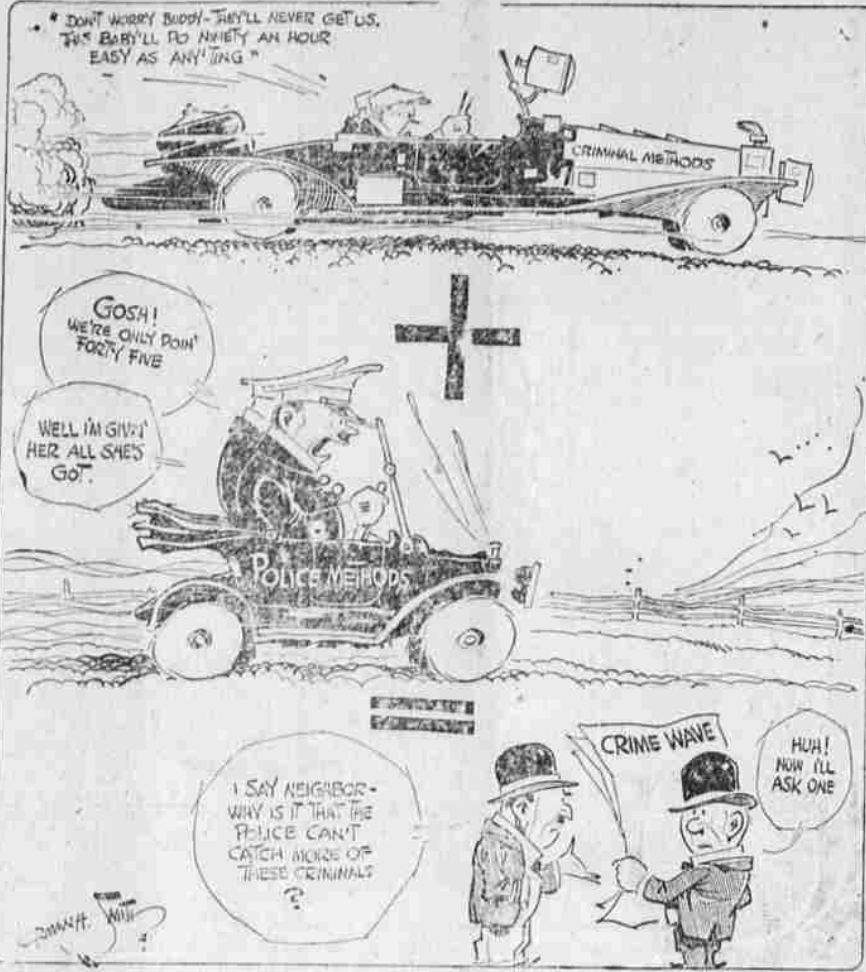
Use of lime on the legume crop in the rotation system is most profitable in Oregon, says the experiment station, because of the effect it has on the follow-up crop. It is not best ever to use lime on the crop that is more than one season away from the crop on which lime is most beneficial.

Lime has been used as a soil amendment for many centuries, says the Oregon State Land Board. For more than a hundred years it was known to benefit some crops. In some European countries as well as in some American states it is customary to lime the land regularly every six or seven years.
