Tomatoes Stuffed with Oysters—Four medium sized tomatoes, 8 large oysters, 1 cup of cracker crumbs, 2 tablespoons butter, salt and pepper.

Wash tomatoes and cut a slice from the stem end. Scoop out seeds, leaving a firm shell. Sprinkle inside of tomatoes with salt and turn upside down for 20 minutes...
