

AUTO OUTPUT RECORD MADE

First Half of 1925 Finds 2,173,360 New Cars and Trucks Manufactured in America.

With an output of 2,173,360 cars and trucks during the first six months of 1925, the automobile industry of this country established a new record of manufacture.

The June output of cars and trucks totals 402,696, which is the largest June in the history of the business.

On Conservative Basis Reports from the retail trade at the meeting of the directors of the national automobile chamber of commerce held in Buffalo this week indicated that the activities of the industry are on a conservative basis.

The totals for the six months were as follows: January 824,546, February 876,326, March 893,423, April 884,267, May 921,554, June 402,696.
