Andes Are Geologically the World's Infant Mountains

BALTIMORE (AP)—The Andes are geologically the world's baby mountain range, in the opinion of Joseph T. Singewald, professor of geology at Johns Hopkins university.
Returning from an exploration trip along the waters of the upper Amazon river in Peru, Professor Singewald says red beds containing fossils have been located on both the east and west sides of the inner range of the Andes, indicating that these mountains are at least 10,000,000 years younger than previously believed.
This discovery, with the added fact that fossils also were found at an elevation of 14,000 feet, convinces the professor that the Andes is the youngest large mountain range.
