ROSEBURG, Ore.—A proposal to vote a 1-mill levy for a period of four years to construct a new

courthouse and jail building will be submitted to the voters of the county at the primary election, a recommendation to that effect having been adopted today by the Douglas county taxpayers' league. The courthouse has been condemned as a fire trap by numerous

grand juries.

The tax league made a careful study of the county budget recommending a few changes and additional appropriations. The continuation of the health unit was urged, as was also co-operation with the city of Roseburg in main-

taining the public library.
