ESTATE WINS IN LITIGATION

The estate of William D. Grady, deceased, at one time president of the city commission of La Grande and a prominent rancher and stockman in the valley, has just won two important victories in the courts, both revolving around one of the decedent's ranches in the state of Washington.

Just prior to Mr. Grady's death while he was very weak, both physically and mentally, he was induced to sign as surety the note of a tenant on this particular ranch in Washington. The note was in favor of the People's State bank of Walla Walla.

After Mr. Grady's death in 1922, the bank started action in the district court of Franklin county, Washington, against the Grady estate to recover approximately \$5,000 on the note. R. J. Green, La Grande attorney, tried the case for the estate.

It was the contention of the defendant that Mr. Grady had been induced to sign the note at a time when he was mentally incapable on account of his extreme illness and weakened physical and mental condition, and that he was the victim of undue influence. The jury brought in a verdict for the Grady estate.

A dispute over the levy of the federal income tax resulted in the other case. A value of approximately \$215,000 placed on the gross estate by the government for the purpose of taxation was held by the estate to be \$20,000 too high.

The real controversy arose over the valuation placed on the ranch in Washington. Mr. Grady had traded to the ranch, taking it in on a trade valuation of \$49,700. The government contended that the value placed on the land by the decedent when he received it in a trade should be the valuation placed on it for taxation purposes. Attorney Green, on the other hand, contended that an actual fair market value of the land, and not a

fictional one assumed for trade purposes, should apply.

An appeal was taken to the commission of internal revenue. And a decision has just been handed down upholding the contention of the estate. The total valuation for taxation purposes has been reduced approximately \$25,000.

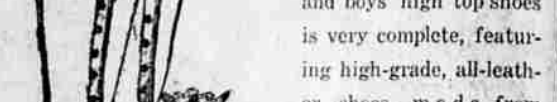

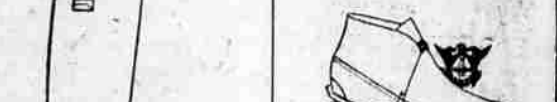

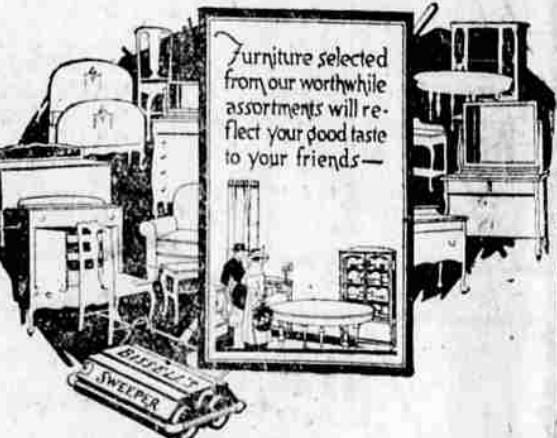
