POOR LIGHT IS GREAT HAZARD

Frank A. Pim, Illuminating Engineer, Advises Careful Adjustment of Headlamps.

EUGENE, Ore. (Special).—The primary requirements of standard specifications for control of automobile headlights such as have been approved by the government...

The average motorist knows nothing of the care of his headlights and does not attempt to give them any care, says Pim.

He will work on his car Sunday morning preparatory to taking a trip in the afternoon and he will work on all parts of the car.

Adjustment Simple. A simple method of procedure that could be followed by a motorist would be to park his car on a level space of ground about 25 feet from a wall or garage door...

It is a well-known fact that when you enter a dark room the iris becomes large to admit all the light in that room to pass into the eye...

Suppose, then, that you are driving your car down the highway with your lights dim, or with insufficient illumination. The pupil of the eye enlarges the same as in the dark room because you have poor light in front of you...

Under this condition if you are moving at 35 miles an hour, you will travel in 2.4 seconds just 144 feet, and it is in this period you lose your sense of bearing and possibly also lose the control of your car.

Motorists who do not want to take care of their headlights themselves should suggest to their garage men that their headlights be adjusted according to specifications.

Old Oregon Trail Bill Referred to Committee

WASHINGTON (Special)—The Old Oregon Trail bill has made a new start in the house, introduced by Congressman Smith, of Idaho, it has been referred to the house committee on roads, where it perished at the last congress after passing the senate.

The bill divides the trail at Caldwell, Ida., one branch running via Payette, Ida., the other via Ontario, Ore., to Weiser, Ida., then through Huntington, Baker, La Grande, Pendleton and Umatilla and down the Columbia river to Portland and the sea.
