Students Learning to Fly At University Night School
 MADISON, Wis. (AP)—Students in hot down universities of the middle west are learning to fly. They are enrolled in naval aviation courses in the University of Wisconsin, the University of Minnesota, Washington University at St. Louis, Case University, Purdue and the University of Chicago.
