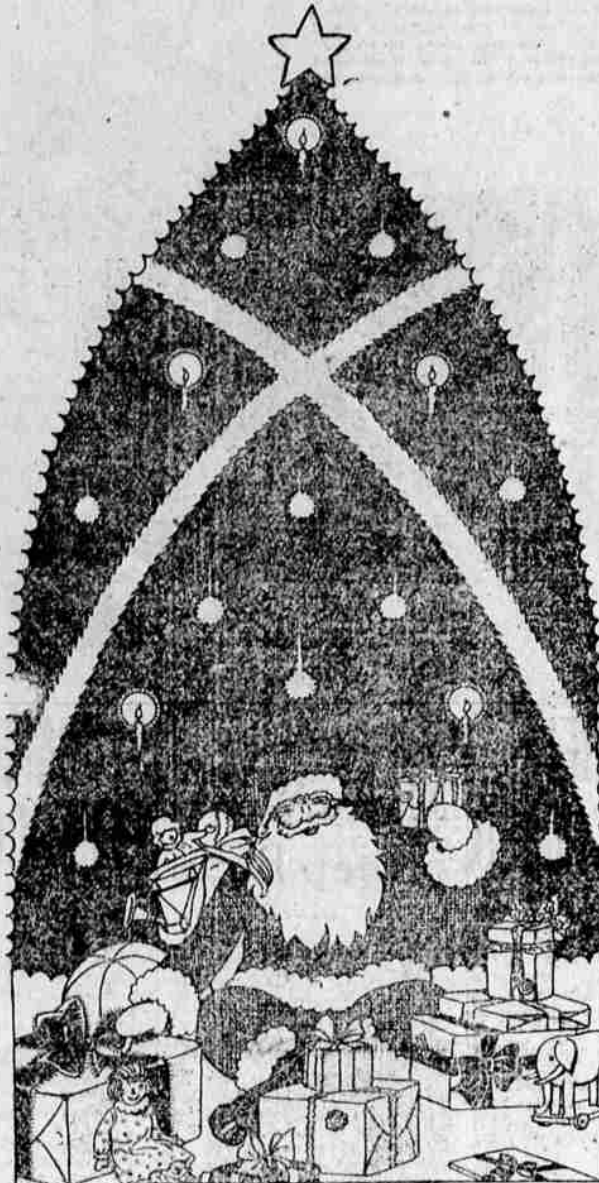

Billy Evans Says:

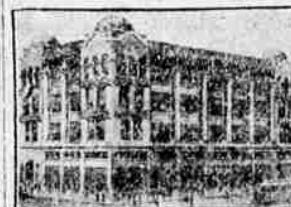

So remarkable a game did he play, that I am told Coach Dr. John Wines informed him at its finish that he had the position of guard clinched for the coming year. It is said to be the first time Coach Wines ever did such a thing.

In his last two appearances, before a physician demanded that he be rested or suffer serious consequences, Grange not being fit, played poorly. He was looted and missed.

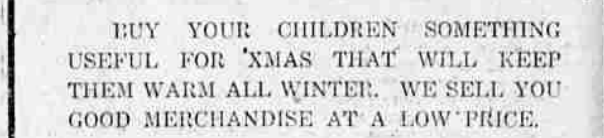
In that sense he has already come to realize the difference between the college and professional game. You must deliver all the time as a pro if you would get the grand haul.

SEATTLE (AP)--Rain that had brought the total for December to 4 1/2 inches, half an inch above the normal for the month in this city, continued Monday as the University of Washington held its eighth practice in preparation to

play football at Pasadena, Cal., January 1 with the University of Alabama.
