STAYTON Water Found Impure. STAYTON, Ore.—It has been found that the city water is unfit for drinking, following analysis at Oregon Agricultural college and the state bureau of health. The situation is especially bad at the schools, where water from a private well, which it is said has not been tested, is carried in buckets to the rooms and no individual drinking cups have been provided.
