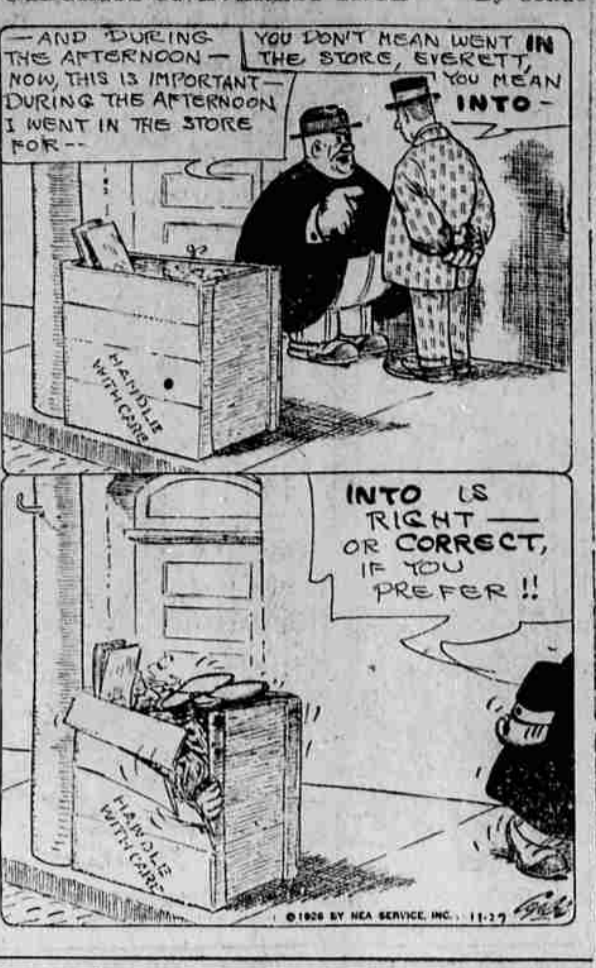

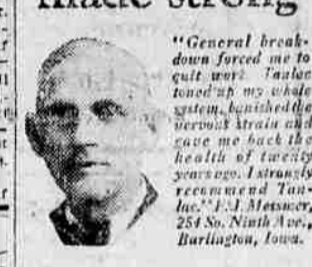
California in '49 was a hot bed of crime and disorder, the law for sale and land being superior to conventional systems of life and death. The law was what men made it.
