Popular Verdict Given To Rich Fare of New American Music

CHICAGO (AP) — Distinctly American music has had its day in court and won a popular seasonal verdict. Probably in no previous year has such a rich fare been presented for festive music lovers. They have been treated to original forms of music from jazz symphony to grand opera in a series of productions ranging from New York to San Francisco. In addition, opera in English received a decided impetus and American singers won considerable notice.

George Gershwin, Deems Taylor, Lou Saverio, John Alden Carpenter, W. Frank Harling, Eric Delamarter and Charles Wakefield Cadman, are beginning to show prominently in the new music. Gershwin, who has a number of musical comedies and light operas, has broken the barrier by his "Rhapsody in Blue," which Paul Whiteman's band helped to popularize. Deems Taylor, who has a number of operas, has a new opera, "The Sign of the Cross," which is being produced by the New York Symphony Orchestra, conducted by Walter Damrosch, and then presented in "15th Street," a new art opera with its libretto by the Harlan, Clark best.

There were melodies that ran riot on the stage ten and fifteen years ago, others from the Kentucky mountains, still others from the more recent dance orchestras, all blending into what the composer called a "symphony for fun."

Chicago also heard this season a modern orchestral work by Mr. Saverio, who remembering the success of his "Krazy Kat" and "Singsong from a Frenchman's Point of View," also took an upward curve when the Chicago Civic Opera company produced Aldo Pinchetti's "Nankin Nankin" and Mr. Harling's "A Light from St. Agnes." A third American opera, Cadman's "The Which of Which," originally scheduled for production last season, was held over until this year. Meanwhile, Mr. Cadman has arranged with a Washington opera company for the production of an opera based on an Indian story.

His first recognition came in 1924 when his singing of the role of Ford in Falstaff brought great commendation.
