MOSCOW (AP)—At the All-Russian Communist Party Congress in Krenlin, N. I. Bukharin, one of the highest communist officials in Soviet Russia, declared that inquiries among the membership of the Young Communist League showed that from twenty-five to thirty per cent of the members are confirmed drunkards.

He also said that among the less stable elements in the organization anarchist tendencies and "hooliganism" had developed at a disturbing rate.
