Maxim Gorky Working On Novel "Explorer"

NAPLES, Italy, Mar. 24. (AP)—Maxim Gorky, the famous Russian author is hard at work on a novel entitled "The Explorer," which, taking a character from 1890 to 1925, contains a description of the world war, the Russian revolution and contemporary Italian conditions. The work is to be published soon by the official printers of the Soviet government.

Gorky is staying at the Villa Galvani at Positano, surrounded by a few intimate Russian friends and is refusing to receive visitors.

Grand Jury Will Sift Murder Charge at Bend

BEND, Ore., Mar. 24. (AP)—The Crook county grand jury has been called to meet March 25 to sift charges which have arisen as a result of the death of Vayle Taylor, who died as the result of a shot from the pistol of C. C. McBride, state prohibition officer.

The coroner jury found death resulted from the accidental discharge of McBride's gun and completely exonerated the officer.

The accident happened on the high desert country, 40 miles from Bend and over the line in Crook county, February 18. Friends of Taylor's in the high desert country were reported soon after the funeral to have engaged attorneys and provided a fund to gather evidence refusing to accept the verdict of the coroner's.

CHICAGO, Mar. 24. (AP)—Twenty-two men were indicted on a table upon plans of two women employed in the county hospital kitchen to show their displeasure at not getting a raise in pay.

The housekeeper on whose table the kitchen was spilled discovered the disgruntled women had smeared green soap on the check-box for a special dinner, put salt in the coffee, pepper in the oatmeal, and what not.

The hospital warden sent for Gorky's brother, a police official, who secured confessions last night after taking the fingerprints. The women were suspended.
