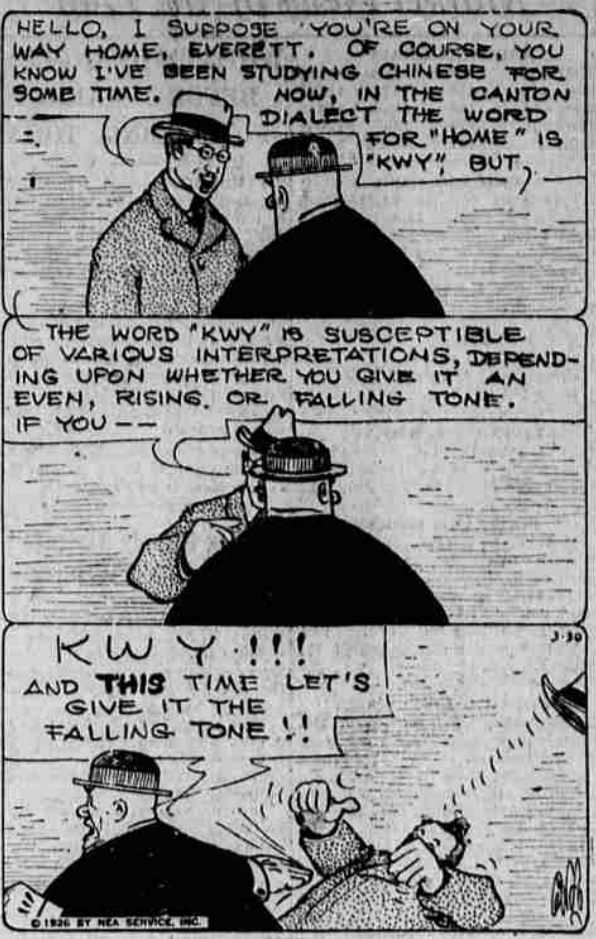

There is a peculiar affinity between the emulsion salts of silver with which the film is coated and the ultra-rays of the lightning. Unless the celluloid is handled by an expert, dire consequences may result.

Happily, the labors of Montez were unattended by any dangers and a thunderstorm unsurpassed for its realism will be seen in "Blue Blazes" which will be seen at the Star theater Wednesday and Thursday.

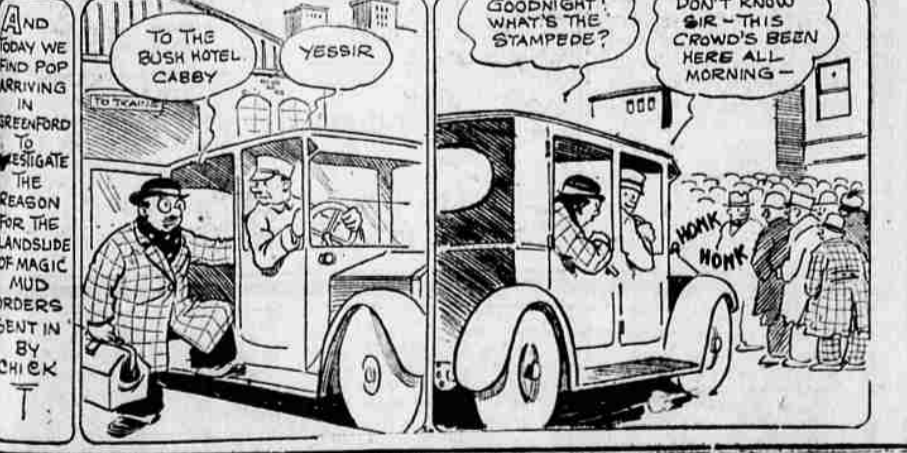
