HELLMAN WINS OVER FILIPINO

PORTLAND, Mar. 31. (AP)—Chuck Hellman, Portland bantamweight, scored a ten-round decision over Young Nationalista, Filipino, of Los Angeles, here last night. Hellman was awarded a belt emblem of the Pacific coast bantam championship, donated by the Portland boxing commission. Alie Taylor, of Bend, Ore., knocked out Danny Edwards, Portland bantamweight, in the fifth round of the six-round semi-final.

Paul Amort Defeats Anderson of Portland

ROSEBURG, Ore., Mar. 31. (AP)—Paul Amort, of Roseburg, won two out of three falls from Jimmy Anderson, Portland wrestler, in a fast match here last night. Amort took the first fall with a head scissor and wristlock in 32 1-2 minutes. Anderson came back strong and took the second fall in five minutes with a Japanese wristlock. After seven minutes of

fast wrestling Amort won the match with a half Nelson and arm bar. Amort weighed 161 and Anderson 160.
In the semi-final Roy Cedarstrom, of Marshfield, beat George Pete of Glendale. Pete won the first fall in 18 minutes, but was thrown by a flying winglock after 12 minutes more of wrestling and received an injured shoulder which prevented him from continuing the match.

CLASS TRACK MEET IS DATED

La Grande high school tracksters will engage in their first bit of spring competition Saturday at 2:30 p. m., when the season opens with an interclass meet on the athletic field. Everybody is invited to be there, and no admission will be charged.
The interclass meet will show what stuff we have to depend on in the Eastern Oregon track. Coach Thornton Bennett observed this morning. "From Saturday on, we'll concentrate on fellows who can produce for the rest of the season. Our training so far has been very general. There are still four weeks in which to work, and that's time enough to get in some hard hits. Track men have to be watched against going stale."
Each of the four classes has rounded up a team of track and weight men for the meet. The upperclassmen, of course, have the advantage, since their members include most of the letter men from past seasons.
"And the old men are the ones that count in most track competition," remarked the Coach. "Building track men is a long, slow process if you want to get results."
Just about all the events that high school athletes excel in are scheduled for Saturday's program: 100, 220, 440, 880-yard and mile dashes; 120- and 220-yard hurdles; pole vaulting; broad and high jumping; shot putting, discus and javelin throwing; half-mile relays with 220-yard runs for each man.

Benny Dotson Wins by Technical Knockout

CLAMATH FALLS, Ore., Mar. 31. (AP)—Benny Dotson was declared the winner in his fight here with Ace Bole, of Marshfield, last night when he requested the referee to stop the slaughter. Bole was knocked down three times but gainedly kept coming back. Bole weighed in at 121 and the fight was begun under protest when Dotson refused to be weighed. Bole's manager claiming the Portland lightweight weighed 142.
Benny Woods, of Bend, won a six-round decision in his fight with Jack Crima, Modoc Indian, welterweight.

\$100,000,000 Crop of Pineapples Forecast

HONOLULU, Mar. 31. (AP)—Pineapple growers in the Hawaiian Islands are looking to the day when the territory's pineapple crop will be worth \$100,000,000.
In less than twenty-five years the industry has been built up to \$25,000,000 a season and with the world demand for this fruit increasing, the \$100,000,000 mark seems only a few years distant.
It takes only eighteen months to mature pineapple so the increase in size of the crop for a given year can be arranged in advance.

SHE-COP SHOT HIM

SAN DIEGO, Cal. (AP)—Edwin Gearlds camped in Balboa park in defiance of a park regulation. Police Officer Jessie M. Long was summoned to enforce the ruling. Gearlds refused to leave and dared the woman officer to shoot him. After firing a shot into the ground which had no effect on the man she sent a second bullet through his left knee. Gearlds was removed to a hospital with an entirely new respect for peace officers of the "weaker sex."

(AP)—Mike Yokel, veteran wrestler, defeated Hallor Jack Woods in their match here last night when Woods was unable to return to the mat after Yokel had thrown him by means of an airplane spin. Woods took the first fall with a headlock in 35 minutes. Yokel gained the last fall in 25 minutes, five seconds.

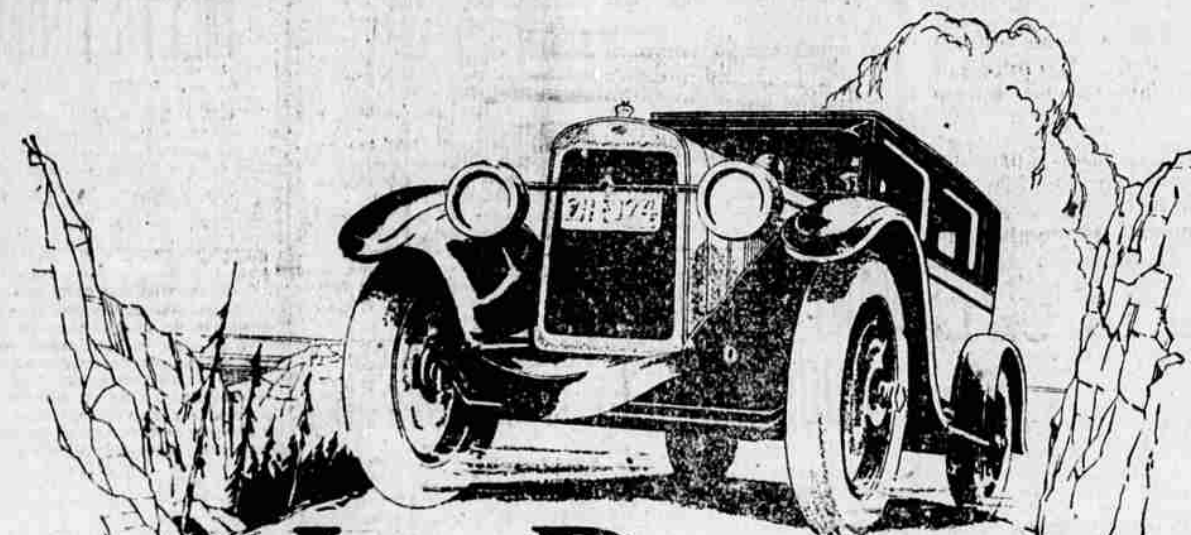
Powder Explosion Is Fatal to Young Farmer
