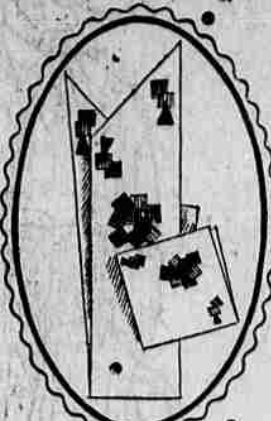

Sister Mary Says:

Breakfast—Stewed rhubarb, broiled bacon, creamed potatoes, rye muffins, milk, coffee.
Luncheon—Tomato chowder, croquettes, cottage cheese salad, brown bread, milk, tea.

Dinner—Filets of sole with spinach and creole sauce, new potatoes, stuffed prune salad, pineapple soufflé.

Keeping in mind that children and invalids should not be served new potatoes. A new potato might be compared to unripe fruit; the starch grains are immature and difficult to digest.

Filets of Sole.
Six filets from 2 flounders, 2 pounds spinach, 2 cups creamed tomatoes, 1 teaspoon salt, 2 tablespoons butter, 1 cup broken mushrooms, 2 tablespoons flour, 1 teaspoon onion juice, 1 green pepper.

Put fish into sauce pan and pour over boiling water to cover. Add 1 tablespoon vinegar and simmer for ten minutes. Drain. Wash spinach through many waters and cook in the water that clings to the leaves. Let water cook away as much as possible after spinach is tender. Chop and arrange in the bottom of a well-buttered baking dish. Place poached filets over spinach and pour over the sauce. Sprinkle with grated cheese and put into a moderate oven to make thoroughly hot and melt cheese.

To make sauce rub tomatoes through coarse sieve. Add salt and a dash of pepper. Melt butter and saute mushrooms. Add mushrooms to tomatoes. Stir flour into butter in which mushrooms were cooked. When smooth stir into tomatoes and cook, stirring constantly until thick and smooth. Add onion juice and pepper finely chopped. Remove seeds and membrane before mincing pepper. Pour over fish.

TWO WOMEN MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO STATE ASYLUM

SALEM, Ore., Apr. 9. (AP)—Mrs. C. H. Bailey, aged 71, a woman, who was received at the state penitentiary a few months ago under sentence for beating a grand daughter so severely that the child died, may be transferred to the insane hospital.

After completing observation of Mrs. Bailey, Dr. Steiner has recommended to Governor Pierce that she be transferred. He believes she was insane at the time she beat the child, who later died. The woman received an eight-year sentence.

Mrs. Myrtle Vance, who was received at the state penitentiary about three months ago for being implicated in the Roberts store robbery in Portland, is under observation at the insane hospital and may be transferred to that institution.

Bobbed Hair Bad For Poise, Claim

HULL, England.—Bobbed hair is bad for poise in the opinion of Miss Helen Drummond, physical culture instructor at the Osterberg Training College for Girls at Dartford. In a lecture on athletics in girls' schools Miss Drummond advised against short hair for young women in training because it was opposed to good posture.

"Bobbed hair results in uncontrolled movements of the head as the bobbed girl is forever throwing back her head to keep her hair from her face," she said.

INNISBRUCK, Austria.—The advocates of bobbed hair have been defeated in a conflict between the mayors of the North Tyrol communities and the hairdressers. The mayors decided to impose a tax on any woman having her hair short and against like the hairdressers protested vehemently.

"If a woman have long hair it is a glory to her, for her hair is given her for a covering."

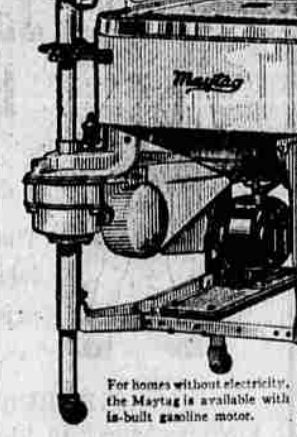
The hairdressers now have abandoned their opposition.
