Early Start on Early Radishes

The radish is the first vegetable to go into the ground and one vegetable that every gardener seems certain to plant. We now have a

bewildering array of radish varieties and it is only necessary to select according to shape and earliness. The little round extra-early can go in now. Some that need a longer season may be planted at the same time and with them some of the long red or white ones which need a still longer period. Three rows will give a succession with one planting and two weeks later the same succession can again be sown.

Radishes are cool weather vegetables. They are tender, crisp and snappy after the fast growth of early spring. In the hotter weather of midsummer they get pithy and fiery. We now have summer and fall radishes of a different type, much larger, approaching turnips and carrots in size that grow in the hot weather and keep up the radish succession and offer fine material for slicing in salads.

The main feature in getting good radishes is good digging. If the soil is well worked, pulverized fine, and is reasonably fertile, anybody can grow radishes in a hurry. The well-tillied soil makes it easier for the taproot to reach down for the food which fattens it into the round spiky globe to tempt the palate a little later.

It is better not to give the soil in which radishes are planted fresh manure. The prepared commercial fertilizers, either natural or chemical, will be better than fresh stable manure. Wood ashes are an excellent dressing for radish beds as, like most root crops, a potash fertilizer is the most effective in developing root growth.

A gardener needs five kinds of radish seed—extra early, early, late crop, summer and winter. One mistake that is made in nine out of ten cases is sowing the seed too thick. The radish must have room to develop. If the plants are standing crowded in the row only a percentage of them will have a chance. Thin them to an inch apart as soon as they are up.
