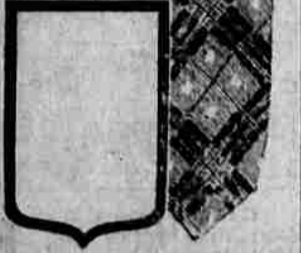

WOOL MARKET FALLING OFF

PORTLAND, Ore., May 6. (AP)—The stagnant condition of the wool market in the Pacific northwest has prevailed for some time. It is no secret to the trade and growers and dealers alike are laboring under no delusion. While a large amount of wool is finding its way to Portland for storage, there is little or no trading. Buyers are out of the market holding stocks already purchased for a more favorable turn. Business from the east is limited with bids at an impossible low level. There is no doubt but what eastern mills are taking full advantage of the British strike situation. The purchase of 800,000 pounds of Jericho pool this week at 24 1/2¢ is considered a bargain by the trade here and no criterion as to the future trend of the market. The Jericho pool of 85,000 fleeces was purchased by the B. Harris Wool company of St. Louis. Last year the pool brought 42 1/2¢ and was sold when the market was at the bottom level. Compared to last year's sale wool values are fully 8 cents lower in the west.

19,000 Umatilla Lambs Sold at \$10.50 @ \$10.75

PENDLETON, May 6. (AP)—Nineteen thousand head of Umatilla lambs have been sold or contracted for, according to reports received here. The lambs brought \$10.50 and \$10.75, which is considered a good price now that wool prices are lower than a year ago. Nine thousand of the lambs were sold to a Baker, Ore., man and the other 10,000 were bought by a San Francisco firm.

Wool Contracting Is Stopped by Strike

SAN ANGELO, Tex., May 6. (AP)—Contracting of Texas spring wool ceased here yesterday after half a dozen wool buyers with headquarters in San Angelo, known as the leading American inland wool market, received orders to discontinue all offers as a result of the British strike.
