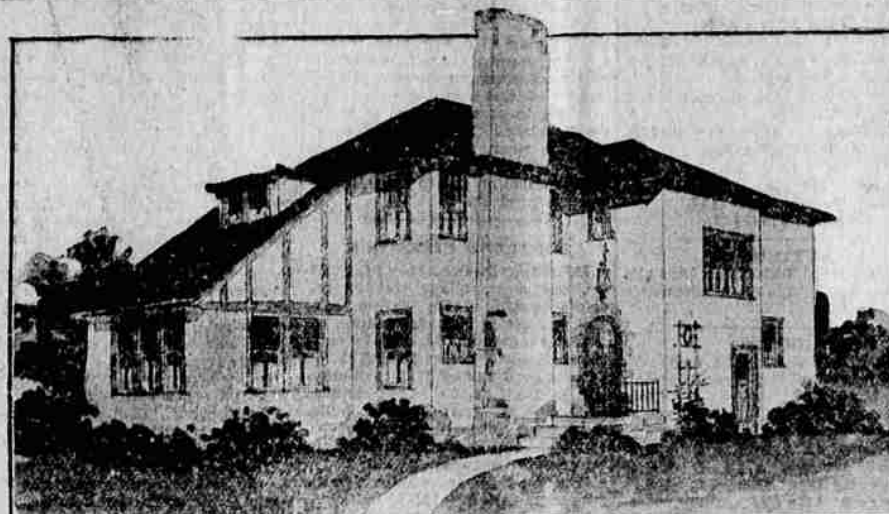

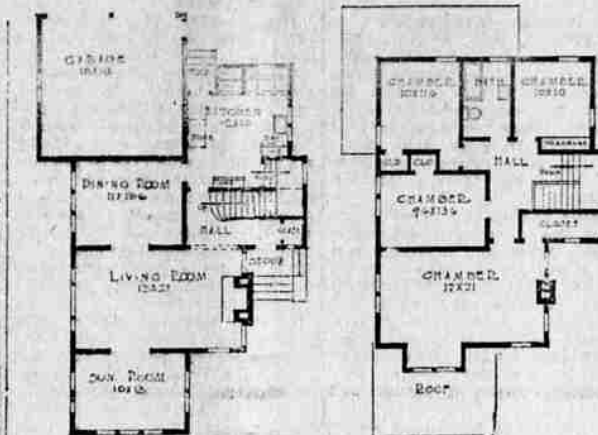

here shown was designed for a corner lot, with the garage on one corner and the driveway from the alley. The service door is sheltered by an overhanging roof and it is convenient to a rear entrance. Near this rear entrance is a small closet conveniently placed for garden tools, etc. The large massive chimney with stone work at the base is an important feature of this design. The entrance door is simple with a stone arch and an ornamental bracket light. From this uncovered stoop one enters directly into a small entrance hall, where an attractive stairway leads to the second floor. Between the living room and dining room, as well as between the hall and living room, there are large plastered arches. One enters the sun room that is off the living room by way of French doors. The kitchen portion is very convenient with a grade entrance and breakfast alcove. The large owner's chamber with three sides exposed is very desirable and provides for an abundance of light and ventilation. The other bed rooms are of a good size, with ample amount of closet space. The full basement is complete with boiler room, laundry, furnace room, and fruit room, and storage space. The exterior walls are of frame construction, of a somewhat rough texture cream colored cement, applied over metal lath. The roof is of variegated slate, which gives this home a very substantial appearance. The estimated cost of this very attractive type home is

\$10,000, this is exclusive of heating and plumbing, and with the best of construction throughout the entire home. Hard wood floors are in the main rooms, with pine for painting on the second floor. The doors are birch stained walnut and the floor and wainscoted in the bath, with shower over tub.



Mr. Gordon of the Gordon Company, Manufacturers of water-proofing materials of Portland, Oregon, came through La Grande and stopped off. Mr. Gordon is a big man, however, he only weighs about 145 lbs. I guess the biggest part is back bone. They manufacture the Duralastic Asbestos Liquid Cement to be applied with a brush. It is made of long-fiber asbestos. It helps to fire-proof, sun-proof and water-proof your metal and fiber roofing. It does not sell quite so reasonable as some of the old coal tar products that are put out by Cleveland, O., and other eastern skin-game companies. But the cheapest is like a Ford car—it is cheapest in the long run. Mr. Gordon was very much impressed with our establishment in moving so much material to the public, so we are their representative in La Grande, and we have some of their stuff on hand or will have in about three days. Our paint sales Saturday mounted upward close to 100 gallons. We sold a carload of the big lump Royal for \$10.95 a ton delivered off the car and part of the second car. Two cars will be coming instead of one. Phone your orders in and if you don't believe it is good coal, ask Grandma Zuber. I never paid her a thing to brag on it. But she buys where she can get best material for the least money. Cupboard doors, flour bins and cedar posts.
