Hollywood, Cal.—Al Kaufman, the heavyweight who fought his way to the top of yesterday's heap, fought a draw with Jack Johnson for the world's championship and retired from the ring game before he was twenty-one, was talking about the good old days.

"I don't think the four-round game so much in vogue at the present is developing the sort of men we used to have as boxers," he said. "From the physical culture standpoint, the aim of boxing is to develop strength and endurance—and it is quite apparent that much less of both is needed for twelve minutes of actual fighting than used to be required for hours of milling."

"And the shorter route of today doesn't favor the more scientific man—it favors the slugger. Except in the championship class, I think that boxing is cruder than it used to be. Among the title holders, only one measures up to the greatest traditions of the ring, and he has proved himself as good a boxer as a slugger. That man, of course, is Dempsey."

"Even the amateurs aren't as good as they used to be, heavy-weight years ago a young millionaire named Harbort led the heavy-weight title. Everyone who saw him perform used to wish he'd lose his money, so they could watch him clean up on the heavy-weight professional champion."

"And there is no amateur boxer today as good as Snowy Baker, the Australian sportsman, was when in his prime. He was one of the quickest men who ever stepped inside of four ropes, and it was a pleasure to watch him perform."
