### DENY HEARING FOR C. DYMENT

EUGENE, Ore., June 13. (AP)—Board of regents of the University of Oregon meeting here late yesterday denied a public hearing to Collis Dymont, former dean of the school of literature science and the arts. The proposal for a public hearing was made by a committee from the Ninety-first division association of Oregon.

The session of the regents was lengthy. The Ninety-first division committee came in behalf of Dymont, and asked for a public hearing in which both sides could make known their views on the question, in order to clarify the situation.

The answer of the regents was "no." Mr. Dymont, it was said by the visiting committee, was seemingly given a reprimand while in the capacity of dean of the college of literature, science and the arts, and consequently discharged. Judge James W. Hamilton, of Roseburg, president of the board,

declared that the regents had considered the matter for a long time before taking action, and that the action of the regents was proper in his estimation. A number of new faculty members were chosen by the regents. Ten appointments were made.

### Fire on Jap Steamer Reported Controlled

BREMERTON, Wash., June 13. (AP)—Advices received at the Puget Sound navy radio station here today from a naval station at Dutch Harbor, Alaska, expressed belief that the Ryoto Maru was the Japanese vessel reported burning at sea Sunday.

The Ryoto Maru was reported proceeding slowly to Astoria, Ore. Her position at 12:10 this morning was 50°05 north, 124°29 west in the North Pacific ocean. The fire was understood to be under control.

SIMLA, British India, June 15. (AP)—Eight Moslems were killed and fourteen Christians and nine Sikhs injured in inter-communal riots which broke out at Rawal Pindi last night owing to the suggested erection of a motion picture theater near a mosque. The grain market was destroyed, and extensive looting occurred in the side streets.

Military pickets have been stationed throughout the town and the situation today was well under control.

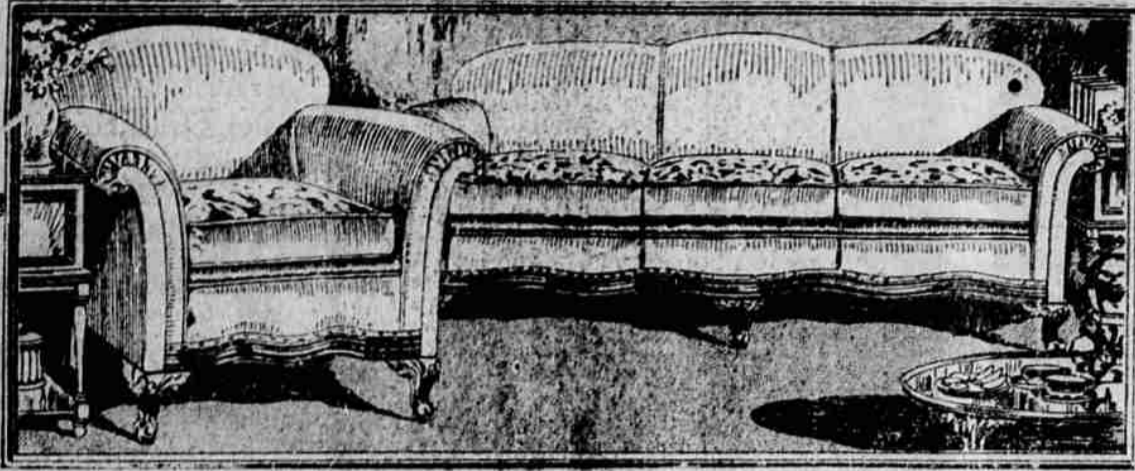

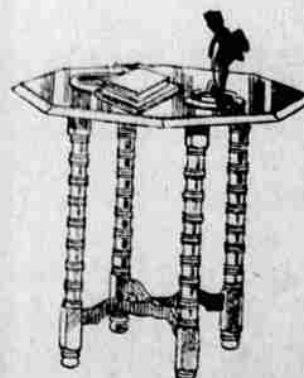
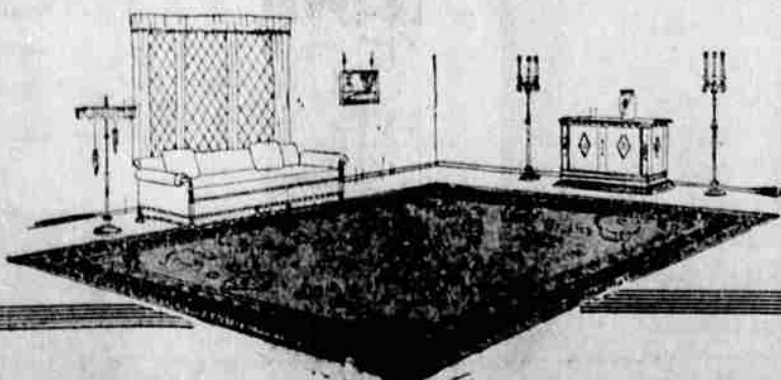
