Lon Chaney Tackles Screen's Most Arduous Dual Role

In the dual role which he plays in "The Black Bird," the next attraction at the Sherry theater, Lon Chaney has, without doubt, achieved one of the most difficult feats ever attempted by any actor. It is not difficult to realize this when it is understood that the dual role was accomplished without resorting to any false noses, whiskers or facial deformities of any kind.

Chaney plays the part of an East End London crook, turned by and sought for by Scotland Yard, in one characterization, and the other role is that of the "Bishop of Limehouse", a kindly soul, loved and pitied by everyone on account of his deformities.
