PULLET EGGS DOWN A CENT

PORTLAND, Ore., June 22 (AP)—A cent decline in pullet eggs is the only change in the local market today. Other grades remain steady. Receipts Monday were 518 cases. Fresh pullet eggs now quoted at 25c.

Both rubes and prints remain steady and unchanged in the local butter market. Production is heavy with the make of city creameries yesterday placed at 27,432 pounds. Cube surplus from country creameries shipped here amounted to 26,277 pounds.

Country dressed meats are steady and yesterday's prices. Top hogs 20c and top calves 15c. Receipts are light.

Receipts of live poultry are light along the street and falling prices are fully maintained. Colored ducks slow at 20 to 21 cents. Other lines unchanged with good demand.

Berry Pack Light. From present indications the 1925 pack of berries and soft fruits will be exceptionally light with corresponding high prices this fall. Canneries are running short of fruit and offering premiums in an effort to obtain sufficient stocks for orders already contracted. Some of the largest packers in the northwest are actually refusing to take any more orders, especially on strawberry packs.

All of those packers call attention to the fact that they have numerous customers who have not yet covered their requirements, and they simply haven't the fruit in sight to take care of this trade when they do decide to buy.

Harvesting took a large portion of the strawberry crop from both Oregon and Washington. Rain during May damaged the crop in this state and prevented proper ripening of Etterberg and Maratholia. The Etterberg crop was only about 40 per cent of normal.

Less Gooseberries. The total pack of gooseberries is considerably less than last year. The crop of black raspberries is hardly normal and canners are receiving few black caps on their contracts with the growers due to better prices elsewhere.

There is a good crop of red raspberries in both Oregon and Washington. Harvest is now well under way with the berries still small but firm and nice. A large portion of the crop has been sold in harvest where market continues firm.

Loganberries appear plentiful again this year. Pack is proceeding rapidly in this state but just starting in Washington. The Oregon crop is large with the fruit excellent quality. Mines, however, are so heavily loaded that berries are medium in size. There may be some difficulty in completing orders for large fancy stock. Canners in this state are now running to capacity to complete orders for the United Kingdom. Whether there will be a surplus or not will not be determined for another week or more.

Cherry Crop Larger. The total crop of Royal Anne cherries is slightly larger than expected, but the cool weather of the last few days is causing the fruit to run to standards and smaller. The black cherry crop is going almost entirely to the fresh market.

CHICAGO, June 22 (AP)—Clearing weather over the southwest which will aid in the movement of the new crop, light rains over the northwest section, where moisture is badly needed, and weakness in Liverpool quotations induced commission house selling on the board of trade today and resulted in lower levels in wheat values. Scattered buying on the breaks took place by traders who were of the belief that the market is over-sold and due for an upturn. This brought about something of a recovery in the late dealings.
