PORTLAND, Ore., July 7. (AP)—Fire damage to the steamer Newport, in dry dock here, will not exceed \$5,000 a major portion of which was caused by holes bored in the sides of the vessel by firemen for hose jets. The fire started among several thousand empty cement sacks in the forward hold of the steamer about midnight, believed to have been caused from plates heated by acetylene torches.

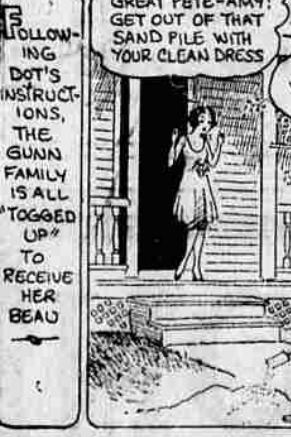

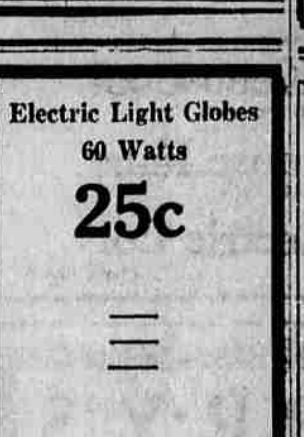
