IO DIE WHEN BUS CRASHES

ST. PAUL, N. Y. July 23. (AP)—Ten women and children, out of 18 who sought to escape the heat of New York city in a bus are dead today.

The driver of a bus, which overturned, was held today in jail. Three other passengers escaped injury. 24 were in hospitals today. The rest were sent home after hospital treatment.

The passengers were returning to their homes in Brooklyn after spending the day in Bear Mountain park.

Witnesses said the bus, driven by Daniel J. Larkin, was speeding prior to the accident. The machine bumped over a curbing in the heart of Sparkhill, New York and 15 feet east of the curbing swerved, then started rolling down a slight incline.

They Star at Scioto Meet

CABINET TASK IS COMPLETED

PARIS, July 22. (AP)—Raymond Poincaré, three times premier and president of the republic during the world war, today announced his fourth cabinet after 26 hours of effort.

The cabinet is composed exclusively of political veterans, including with M. Poincaré, six former premiers. All the cabinet have been cabinet members before with the exception of Labor Minister and he is a son of the late President Falloux.

After visiting the Elysee Palace to inform President Doumergue of his services, M. Poincaré said to the newspaper men:

All Parties are presented. We wanted to form a cabinet of the largest national union in which all parties would be represented, without taking account too closely of the representation of groups. We have tried to fulfill our task in the most high minded spirit possible.

He added that he had found no differences in his path, because he started upon forming the cabinet without regard to personal preferences. He is holding an internal cabinet meeting at his home this afternoon and expects to present the new ministers to the president this evening.
