Cher Husband to War The women play a great part in the preparation of a Druse military expedition. When the tribesmen mount their horses and rally forth to war, only their wives and the elderly women of the tribe have a right to range themselves along their passage and chant odes of encouragement.

Are Excellent Nurses. But it is in nursing the wounded back to health that the Druse women render the most valuable service to their warrior. Handed down to them from generations of warfare, their knowledge of surgery and medicine makes a practical trained nurse out of every mother and sister of the man in the field. They manufacture their own balm and drugs out of herbs and although not officially known as such, can boast of one of the best "Red Cross" in the world.

Wyoming Fossils Sought By Five Universities

CHEYENNE, Wyo., Aug. 5. (AP).—Wyoming may become the "Gold Desert" of the United States.

In search of the fossils of the gigantic mammals and reptiles of prehistoric ages, five universities this summer have sent scientists and students to delve into the rocks of practically every section of the State.

Wyoming was once a huge sea and recently has uncovered a dozen fossils of huge prehistoric eels, fifty to seventy-five feet long. They resembled the fabled sea-serpents.

Huge fossils of the animals of the Jurassic Period in the Mesozoic era have been discovered in central, northern and southeastern Wyoming.

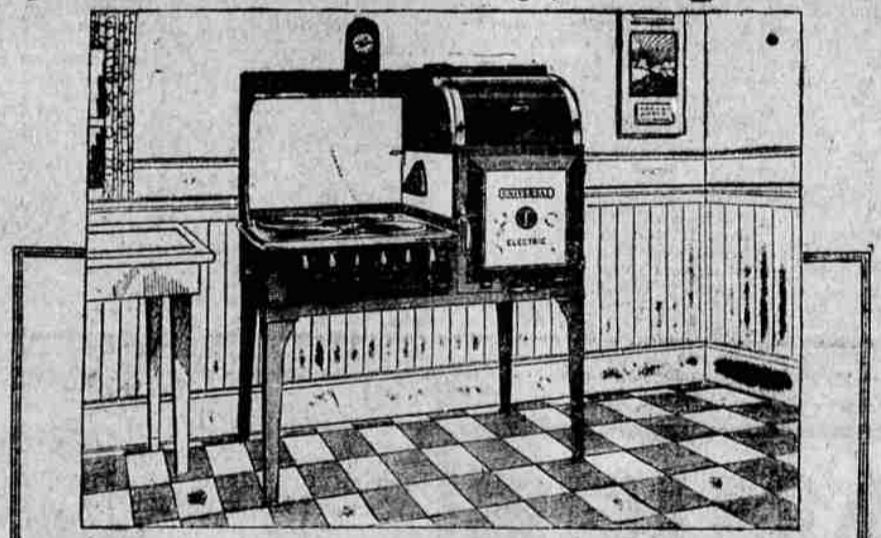
