RUM RUNNERS PICKING FRUIT

ATLANTIC HIGHLAND, N. J., Aug. 11. (AP)—Rum runners are picking berries and hoeing potatoes, while the decks of their slim, swift craft, once piled high with smuggled liquor, are daily buried beneath catches of fish and clams.

There is virtually no risk to any more of the government's attempt to stop rum smuggling in Sandy Hook waters.

The percentage turned against the rum runner when the first Coast Guard boats capable of fifty-two miles an hour were put into service. A dozen fast chasers of one kind or another, are on duty and seven of them keep nightly vigil over the short stretch between Sandy Hook and Fort Wadsworth.

The liquor boys admit their day has passed and every indication supports them. Many of their boats are now used in the fishing trade, others are idle and some abandoned.

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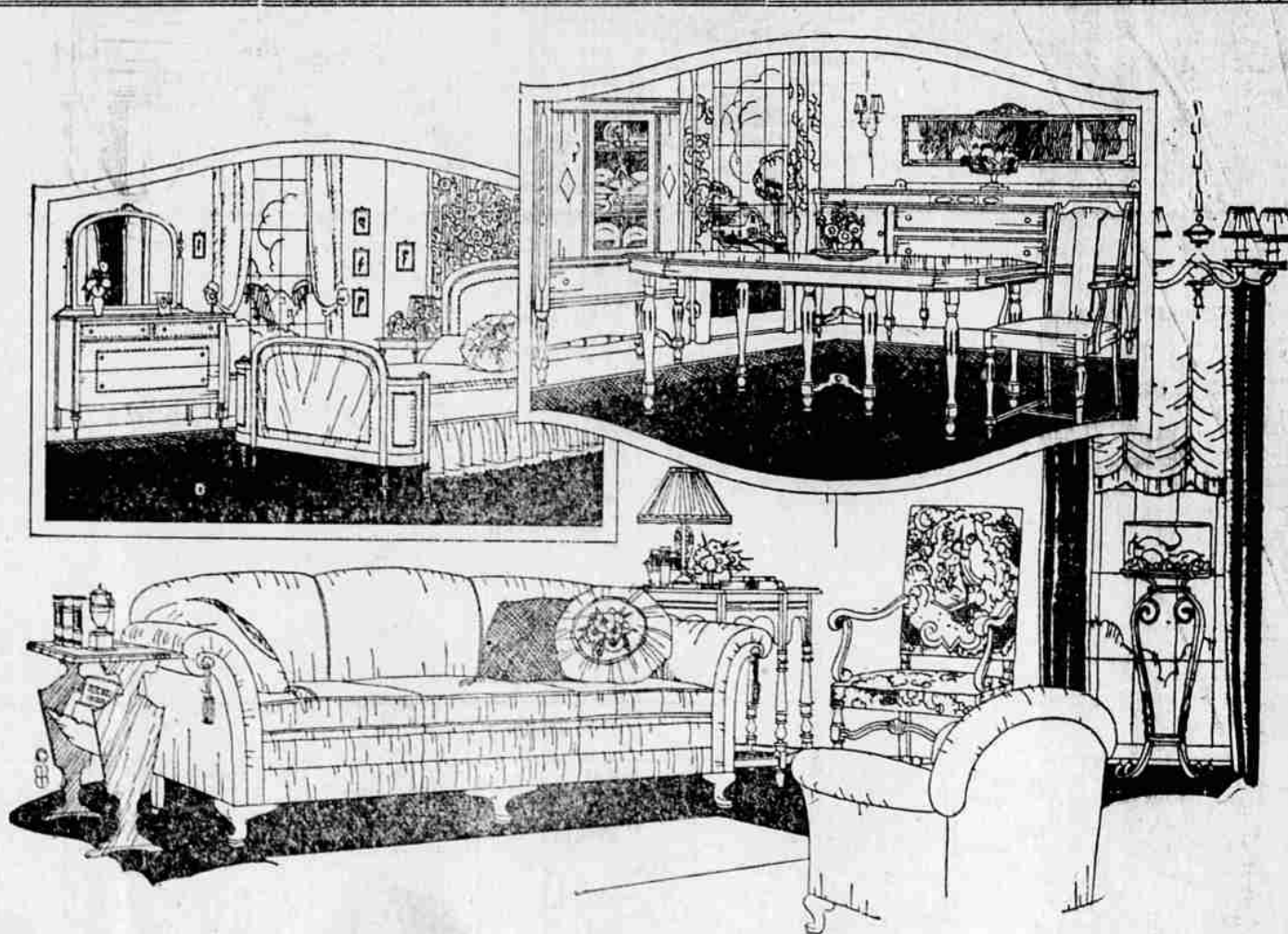
