Fragment of Browne Papyrus Studied by Professors at University of Michigan.

ANN ARBOR, Mich., Aug. 21. (AP)—An ancient scholar, probably the leader of a church, was writer or copist of the earliest fragment of the text of the Bible known to exist...

Dr. Sanders has spent two years working over the bit of browned papyrus, the most cherished item of the large paper collection of the University of Michigan.

Common Greek Tongue. It is written in the Greek of the common people, says Dr. Sanders, thus distinguishing it from the " deluxe city editions" of the complete Bible of Antioch, Alexandria, and Caesarea...

The date of writing of the fragment is placed in the third century or the century preceding that in which the city editions were copied. The text is a part of Matthew, telling of the last supper and the betrayal of Jesus Christ.
