NATURE CALLS TO MOTORISTS

Great Lakes Region Attracts Many Tourists—Many Places of Interest Visited.

CHICAGO, Aug. 11. (AP)—Nature's handwork and primitive people's monumental remains strike with North Woods atmosphere for preeminence in attraction in the Great Lakes region.

Michigan's entire west coast along the lake of the same name is dotted with lakes and summer villages with Mackinac Island one of the chief attractions.

Wisconsin's central, northeastern and northern sections are sprinkled with lakes and forest camping sites. Fishing abounds in all the lakes.

Minnesota's Arrowhead Country Shaped like a long, jagged flint arrowhead, the Minnesota Arrowhead country, containing the Superior national forest, the Jay Cooke State Park the three richest iron ranges in the world and the largest inland port, offers unusual attractions.

Ohio Mounds Ohio points to its Indian mounds as among its attractions. The chief of these is Serpent Mound, 30 miles southeast of Columbus, an earth and rock work, 1,300 feet long with three coiled tails and winding through the shape of a serpent to distended jaws which extend almost to a cliff.

Indiana also boasts of Wyan-dotte Cave, near Corydon, and Turkey Run Park, seven hundred and fifty acres of forest unchanged by the hand of man.

Lincoln's Boyhood Staved rock on the highest of the limestone hills near Utica, Ill., is now a tourist haven but its name commemorates a band of Indians who chose starvation there rather than surrender.

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MORE VISITORS ENTERING STATE THAN LAST YEAR

SALEM, Ore., Aug. 28.—July of 1926 saw more visitors enter Oregon by automobile than any previous month except one since registration of non-resident motor vehicles was begun in June of 1923.

As in the past the flow of tourists and homeseekers chiefly was from the south, with 11,975 cars listed from California alone.

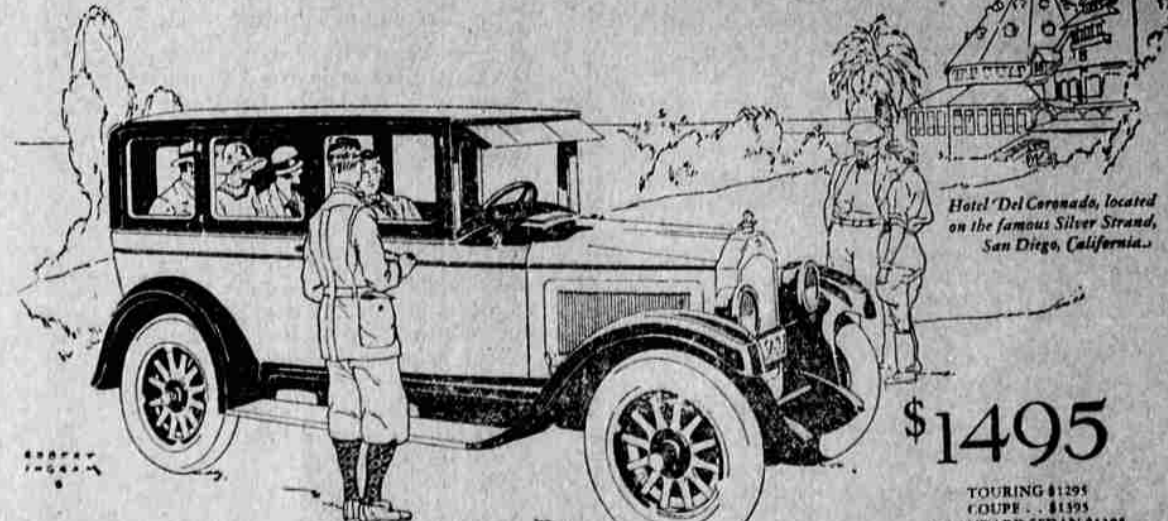
