FOUR MAKE PLEA OF NOT GUILTY

SOMMERVILLE, N. J. Sept. 18 (AP)—Four persons charged with the murder of Dr. Edward Wheeler Hall and Mrs. Eleanor Mills, today were on record as welcoming a trial as an opportunity to prove their innocence...

The state has abandoned or postponed efforts to indict for perjury three or four witnesses against the slain doctors' widow and three of her male relatives.

The four defendants were arraigned last evening and all pleaded not guilty. Mrs. Hall's half of \$15,000 was raised to \$30,000 and her cousin, Henry De La B. Carpenter and brothers Willis and Henry Stevens were held without bail. After arraignment they issued a statement thinking their friends and well wishers and reasserting their innocence of the double murder.

Lime Kilns Will Be Sent to Enterprise

ENTERPRISE, Ore., Sept. 18. (AP)—A telegram has been received at the office of the Black Marble and Lime company from W. D. Demarest stating that he had finished loading equipment for the new Enterprise plant and it fitted eight freight cars. This will start from Sumas, Wash., today and will reach Enterprise next week. Resumption of burning operations at the kiln on the upper slope has been considered, to produce a supply of lime for immediate needs, but if the new plant can be set up and put to work without delay that will not be necessary.

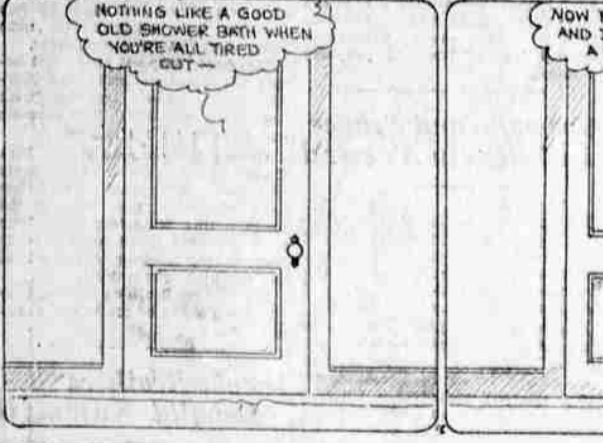

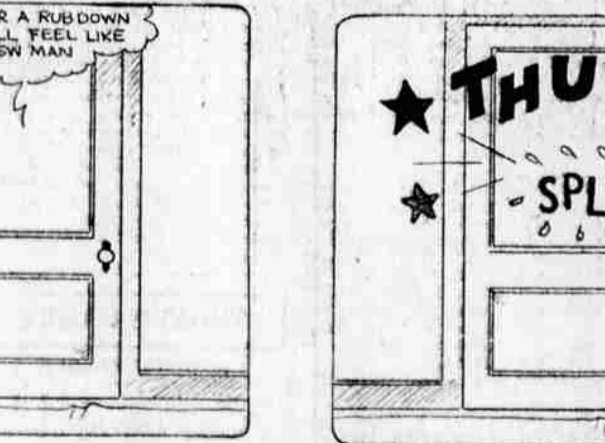
