12-ROUND BOUT WON BY ALLEN

La Grande Boxer Too Clever for Bearcat Bredon, of Boise

BOISE, Ida., Sept. 29.—Science of the art of boxing won a decision for Delmer Allen, of La Grande, over "Bearcat" Bredon in a 12-round bout at the Majestic theatre Wednesday night. The bout was the main event of a card presented by Bert B. Spillman under the auspices of the Emmett Athletic club.

Allen demonstrated all through the bout that he could get through "Bearcat's" defense and hit him but the Oregon boy didn't appear to have a sufficient weapon to put the "Bearcat" out. "Bearcat," on the other hand, demonstrated to the Oregon lad that he had a terrific punch but he lacked ability to make his fists land where he was looking. For six straight rounds Allen bested the West Virginian but with all the punching he did it appeared to have little effect on Bredon.

In the seventh "Bearcat" came out of his defense and with a series of blows to Allen's head and jaw knocked him off his feet. Allen was up in a second but was run into a corner and punished. In the close fighting Allen demonstrated clearly that he was the better boxer. Clever dodges and ducks saved him many blows that might have been damaging.

Both Slog

But the tenth round was the prize taker. It was a regular slug fest from bell to bell. Neither before nor after did the "Bearcat" show such dash. He landed heavily on Allen's jaw with rights and lefts which reflected their force in weakening Allen's condition. Both rested in the eleventh but Allen came back in the last round and nearly ended the bout with a knockout. Several times "Bearcat" was nearly down but Allen couldn't follow his advantage with sufficient force to make him take the count of ten.

GLENNA LOSES TO MISS WILSON

National Women's Golf Champion Dethroned at Merion Today

HAVERFORD, Penn., Sept. 30 (AP)—Glenna Collett was dethroned as title holder in the third round of the women's national golf champion at Merion today by youthful Virginia Wilson, of Chicago, 2 up and one to play.

Miss Collett's defeat came as one of the biggest surprises of a tournament which had already produced many upsets. Her conqueror, a slim, smiling girl of 20, from the Midwest, who never seemed to take the match too seriously, came from behind with a sensational rush on the last three holes after being down to Miss Collett over most of the outgoing nine, winning the 15th and 16th to become two up and then having the 17th hole for victory.

Miss Wilson, outdriven by a wide margin from the tee, displayed marked superiority over the champion in her short game. Her mid-iron approaches and her chip time after time brought applause from a large gallery which braved a pelting rain, while her play on the greens was almost flawless.

Yankees, Cards Both Have Good Hurlers Ready

NEW YORK, Sept. 30 (AP)—There will be no advantage in numbers when St. Louis and New York pitchers are counted in the world's series. Each club has nine in condition. St. Louis has a total of ten, but an injured hand will prevent Johnson's participation.

Pitchers with impressive records are found in each camp. Herb Pennock, of the Yankees, has won the most games, 21. Phil Rhee is one behind. Pennock however, has lost 11 games and has a percentage of .665. Rhee, with seven defeats, is rated .741.

In spite of this excellent profit on paper, he is not expected to start a game in the series, although he may do some finishing. The others will line up against Albany college.

Glenna Collett, women's national golf queen, was put out of the running today at the Merion Cricket club, Philadelphia. She had hoped to duplicate the feat hung up by Alexa Stirling, in 1920, namely, win the championship two years in succession.
