SMALL EGGS UP ONE CENT TODAY

Sluggish Tone Noted in Market for Country Dressed Hogs

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 5 (AP).—Small eggs were a cent higher today, on the basis of an advance in quotations late yesterday. Poultry was quoted at 35c and prices at 25c.

Butter prices were steady. There was a sluggish tone in the local market for country dressed hogs and veal. Poultry also was slow and steady. Improvement in demand, however, was expected shortly.

Hackberries were plentiful at unchanged prices.

Peaches are on the last lap of the season. Prices range from 9c to 65c for small sizes; 75c for mediums and 90c to \$1.00 for large sizes.

California tomatoes of inferior quality were selling at \$1.75 a bag.

Wheat Slumps as Corn and Oats Sag

CHICAGO, Oct. 5 (By the Associated Press).—Opening 1/2 to 3/4 off, wheat soon underwent a further setback. Corn, oats and provisions were also weak, corn starting at 1/4 to 3/4 decline, and then continuing to sag.
