Battery Substitutes Proving To Be Difficult Problem for Radio

(CHICAGO, Oct. 27 (AP)—A battery eliminator, which is correctly known as a "power pack," came into being with the designing of improved rectifiers or current changing tubes and better chemical rectifiers.

Replacement of the storage battery or dry cell supply for lighting receiver tubes offered a somewhat different problem. This battery delivers a current of comparatively high amperage but low voltage.

Alternating current, when cut into a receiver in the raw state, drops out all sound because of the load ripple generated by the rapid variations from positive to negative.

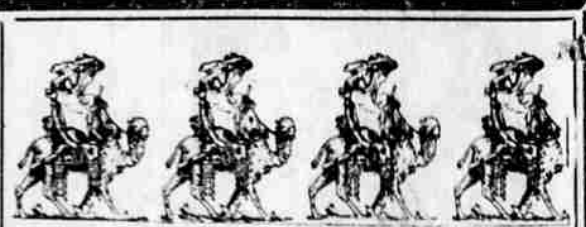
The first step in the use of "A. C." brought the development of the B battery eliminator. It consists of a current changing device and a filter made up of choke coils and large condensers.
