

COOPERATION IS PLEDGED BOARD

Chambers of Commerce Plan to Enter Fight Against Diphtheria

LA GRANDE (Special)—Full cooperation of all Union county chambers of commerce with the state board of health in its campaign against diphtheria was promised when members of the council of county chambers gathered here recently. The anti-diphtheria movement was explained to fellow members of the council by Dr. W. T. Phy, president of the La Grande organization.

"Diphtheria is a preventable disease and the time is drawing near when those who have it will be looked on as criminals against society," said Dr. Phy. "We are now able to eliminate diphtheria from the list of human diseases."

How a course of toxin-anti-toxin will give immunity against diphtheria and the campaign which the Oregon board of health is waging to have all children of pre-school age administered this preventive was told by Dr. Phy. He asserted that while young children have rarely developed immunity and should all therefore be given the course, older children and adults may have become immune and should have the Schick test to find out whether or not they need the toxin-anti-toxin.

To Present Matter
Members of the county council will present the matter before the next meeting of their organizations.

The adoption of the model milk ordinance, drawn up by the agricultural committee of the Union county chamber of commerce, and accepted by the council members will also be presented to the various groups for ratification.

Plans to enlarge Union county's annual economic conference to include commercial and homemaker's interests were discussed. The traces of the county will be invited to sponsor the conference this year.

Dinner was served the council members of the Ladies' library benefit association of this town. Superintendent E. A. Coad, president of the Cove chamber of commerce, presided while those attending included Dr. Phy and Earl Reynolds of La Grande; G. J. Forstrom and R. F. Williams, North Powder; T. T. Cook and Newell Martens, Union; W. W. Binford, Elgin; and Harry Weimer, Cove. J. Y. Wright, secretary of the Elgin group was unable to attend.

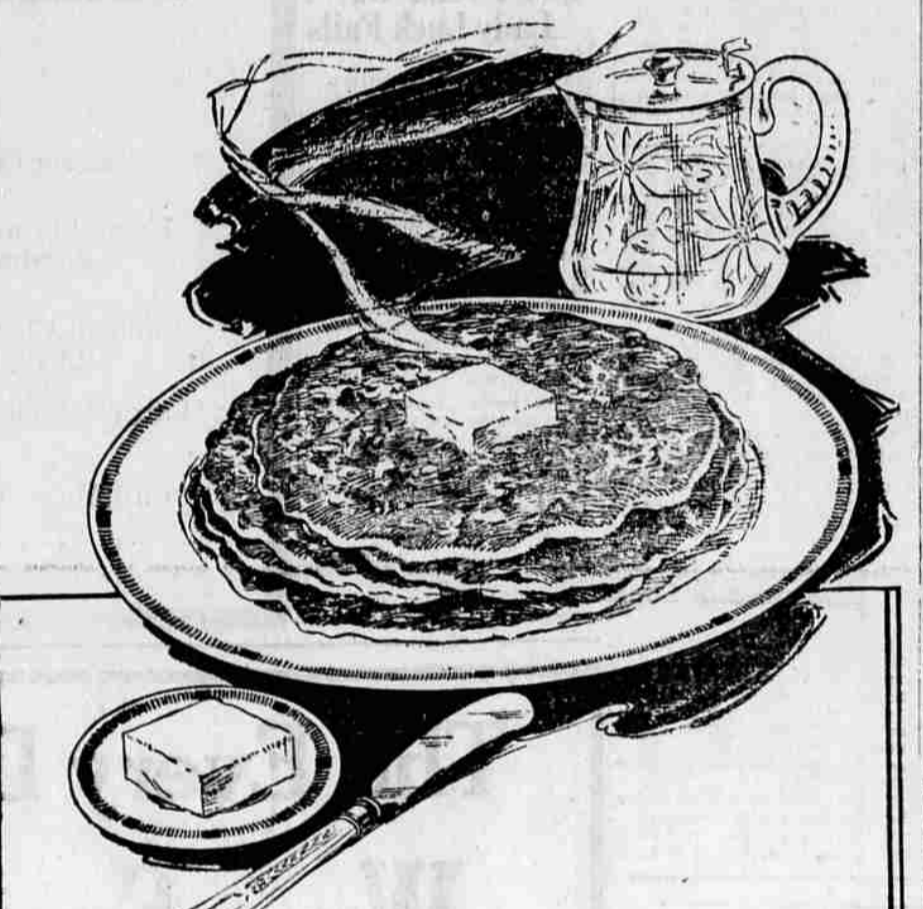

Coal Cost on Par With Vegetables

LONDON, Oct. 29 (AP)—Anthracite, owing to the coal strike which began in May, now costs London housekeepers by the pound as much as potatoes and nearly the same as cooking apples.

Even soft coal costs more than cabbage, carrots and several other winter vegetables which are in demand after the fresh garden supplies are pinched by frost.

Anthracite, by the hundredweight, at the beginning of cold weather, sold for approximately \$1.50 to \$1.75 while soft coal retailed at about \$1.00 for a 12 pound sack.

All sale of coal is regulated by the government, under emergency regulations. Private dwellings are allowed not more than one hundredweight a week, unless there are unusual circumstances which must be explained to the authorities for additional permits.
