Last Showing of "Unknown Soldier" This Evening

It will be a joy to the war mothers and war brides who see "The Unknown Soldier" at the Sherry theatre as smiling through their tears they glory in the greatness and the beauty of the theme and merit of this splendid story.

There could be no greater tribute to "The Unknown Soldier" of America than this graphic impelling screen version of his greatness. Only a director with the artist's touch could handle so delicately a theme, and Renaud Hoffman, who directed the production has done excellent work.

"The Unknown Soldier" is a masterful stroke of realism embellished by a touch of the spiritual which reaches a compelling climax with the triumph of love over death.

The hero of this great war drama is Charles Emmett Mack, and the leading woman is Marguerite De La Motte, Ethel Wales plays the poignant part of "mother" and Henry B. 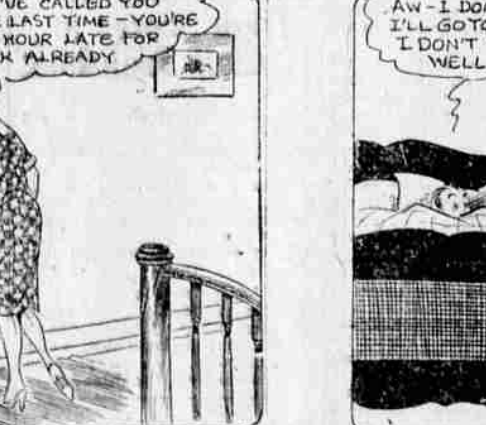

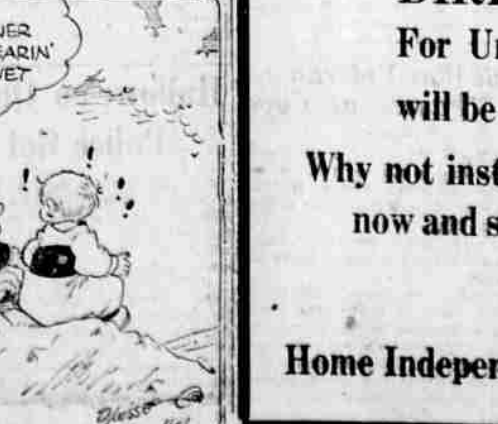
