Oregon Appeal Held Defective By High Court

WASHINGTON, Nov. 2 (AP)—Oregon lost in the supreme court Monday in its effort to prohibit insurance companies from indemnifying motor companies for losses suffered through the confiscation by state officials of autos engaged in violating federal, state or municipal laws.

The court announced that Oregon's appeal was defective and that the decision of the trial court must be affirmed.

When the insurance commissioner of Oregon prohibited the sale of indemnity bonds by insurance companies to cover losses suffered when autos were seized for violating the prohibition laws, the Federal and Deposit company of Maryland and other insurance companies obtained an injunction from the federal district court for Oregon on the ground that it was against public policy to prevent motor companies in selling autos on deferred payments from paying themselves against loss should the machines be seized by the state.
