Sluice Box Put To New Use by Potato Grower

MISSOULA, Mont.—The sluice box, first used in Montana by the prospectors in placer mining for gold, has been revived by a Bitter Root rancher in clearing the frost-damaged potatoes from his stock of tubers.

When R. R. Robinson, rancher of the Stevensville district, dug his potatoes this fall there was no opportunity for handpicking them to eliminate the frost-damaged potatoes. The result was that the lot were hauled to the potato cellar on the place for storage.

After they had been in the cellar for a while, until it was thought the frost-damaged tubers were well on the road to decay, the lot was taken outside and run through a sluice box to eliminate the damaged stock. The sluice box was built about three feet wide and down it 30-foot incline. Water from the irrigation ditch was turned in and the potatoes dumped into the head of the sluice box. The result was that the potatoes in a state of decay were washed away and dissolved and the good ones dropped on a landing platform below. There they were sorted and the entire 20-carload lot was washed and cleaned. They then were returned to the storage bins.

It is said by those who have seen the workings of the sluice box that it was the means of reclaiming potatoes which would otherwise have been ruined, and it is said that Mr. Robinson's potato crop is now in a condition that will make handpicking easy should any more damaged stock be found.
