TURK RECEIPTS SHOW INCREASE

Top Quality Toms Going at 42 Cents—Quotations Uneasy

PORTLAND, Ore., Nov. 18 (AP)—Turkey receipts were increased volume in the Portland market today but were loaded out to retail distributors and to outside markets as fast as the birds arrived. Friday and Saturday receipts will be increased with Sunday probably marking the peak of arrivals.

Although the price is 42 cents for top quality of toms, quotations for choice turkeys may waver early next week. Even now some near top birds are obtainable at 40 cents a pound.

Country dressed veal is a shade weaker. Hogs are steady. The egg and dairy markets are steady with little or no change.

general amnesty and cabinet posts to his liberal opponents would be completed and would end the revolutionary conditions which have invited interference from outside sources, a state of affairs which must cause concern to every friend of stability in Central America.

The warning thus expressed was clearly based on official information of filibustering expeditions out of Mexican ports to aid revolutionary forces in Nicaragua and Guatemala, and Mexico's request at least makes possible the employment of American naval vessels to prevent the landing of such arms and ammunition in his country.

Mexico Concerned
Five gun-running vessels have left Mexican ports for Nicaragua and Guatemala waters, to the Washington government's knowledge, under circumstances which indicate Mexican official connivance and foreshadow in the opinion of responsible American officials similar attempts to promote political disorder in other Central American countries.

For nearly two weeks it has been evident that Mexican-American relations have taken on a more serious aspect than previously in the Washington view and it is now apparent that the long pending oil and land law issues and claim controversies have been overshadowed by the Mexican interference in the political affairs of other central American nations. Presumably the chief purpose of this interference is the fostering of radical propaganda and bolshevist philosophy.

The conflict between theories of government prevailing at present in the U. S. and Mexico has been observed here with concern for some time, since it has been impossible thus far to devise a point of contact which would serve to bring the two together sufficiently to permit the development of understandings and agreements.

BUENOS AIRES, Nov. 18 (AP)—Multitudinous troops in the Brazilian state of Rio Grande do Sul attacked Santa Maria with airplanes and bombs, according to dispatch received over the border by La Nacion. The outcome is not known.

The multitudinous troops numbered about 400. A military force of 100 men was stationed in the town. Bombs dropped from airplanes are said to have destroyed the provincial bank and the principal hotel.

MONTESVIDEO, Uruguay, Nov. 18 (AP)—The Brazilian government today was reported to be sending troops to affected areas in the state of Rio Grande do Sul where revolutionary elements, according to border advisers, have clashed with state troops.

MORE DRINKS IN PENDELTON
PENDELTON, Nov. 18 (AP)—Drunkness in Pendleton is on the increase, according to a report of the police department following a request from the economics department of Yale university. During 1925 there were 225 arrests for intoxication and during the first nine months of 1926 there have been 345 arrests on this charge.

REORGANIZE COMPANY
NEW YORK, Nov. 18 (AP)—An important step in the reorganization of the St. Paul railway was completed here today when a new company, to be known as Chicago, Milwaukee and Pacific railroad company, was organized to succeed the present railway company, now in receivership.

Trading Shifty; Stocks Are Weak

NEW YORK, Nov. 18 (By the Associated Press).—Frequent shifts of speculative sentiment characterized today's stock market, with major activity apparently on the down side. Standard industrial and railroads held fairly well but bear traders succeeded in uncovering a number of weak spots among the specialties. Worthington Pump "B" and Paige-Detroit each broke to new 1926 low prices.

U. S. Steel, General Motors, Baldwin and other recent favorites fluctuated rather erratically within comparatively narrow limits in the first few hours of trading. Rails were quiet but steady. Standard Oil of New Jersey commenced trading at 49 1/4, duplicating the year's low.

The closing was irregular. Fresh selling of U. S. Steel and the weakness of the motor stocks were partially counteracted in the final hour by a brisk uptick in the sugar shares which rallied 1 to 6 points. Total sales approximated 1,500,000 shares.

MARKET NEWS OF THE DAY

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WHEAT GAINS; UNSETTLED AT CLOSING TIME

CHICAGO, Nov. 18 (AP).—Opening 1/4 to 1 1/2 c up, Chicago wheat values reacted somewhat and then hardened again. Corn, oats and provisions also were firmer, with corn starting at 1/4 to 1 1/2 c advance, but later ending at times.

Wheat closed unsettled, 1/4 to 1 1/2 c net higher; corn 1/4 to 1/2 c up; oats unchanged to 1/2 c advance, and provisions varying from 10c decline to a rise of 27c.

Six Miners Are Still Entombed By Flood Waters

HAZLETON, Pa., Nov. 18 (AP).—No signs of life had been discovered today in the flooded workings of the Tomblaken mine where six miners were entombed behind a rush of water Tuesday afternoon and nearly all hope of finding any of the men alive was abandoned.

Rescue work, nevertheless, went ahead with renewed vigor, fresh forces sent to the scene from many parts of the anthracite region filling the gaps made by tired out relays.

The sole ray of hope is pinned on the possibility of the miners having attained a haven high up in one of the gangways before the water and wreckage overtook them.
