derstand why I want to take only three weeks vacation, the reason being that Hall did not want to be away from Mrs. Mills."

Attacks James Mills.

Then came another attack on James Mills, husband of the slain woman.

"I am not here to accuse any one," McCarter said, "but I want to ask you if knowledge of these things is an important fact in this crime, then what about Mills, the husband whose wife for two years had occupied a room in the attic, and had refused to sleep with him, who told him more than once that she cared more for Hall's little finger than for his whole body?"

McCarter asked Mills if he had ever seen Hall in the presence of members of his wife's family and his own brother, was taunted with the statement that when Charlotte had finished her education, his

wife planned to elope to Japan with Hall.

"He was a husband who that very night had quarreled with his wife, who had read the letters sent his wife the night before and who says 'I know the greater part of what was in them.' Those letters were in his house and he says he saw them."

"He knew that the place for exchanging letters was in the church and Mrs. Hall had no key to the church."

"Both his children were out the night of the killing and he, smarting with the quarrel he had had with his wife before she left the house, was alone. He goes out and where he goes no one knows. No one backs him in where he went. He came home about 1:30 or later and no one saw him, but Charlotte says that sometime later he called downstairs, 'has your mother come home yet?'"

"Did James Mills ring up the hospitals when his wife failed to come home? Did James Mills call the police station? Did he even ring up his sister? No, he did nothing that Friday."

"Trading in Honor."

McCarter accused Mills of "trading in his dead wife's honor" by selling for a "filthy \$500 the letters written by Hall to Mrs. Mills, and the minister's diary, which were found in the Mills home after the slaying."

The defense attorney stressed the fact that the letters and diary, revealing the love affair, were found in the Mills home, after the crime.

The defense lawyer enumerated the names of seven of the state's witnesses—Mrs. Gibson, Mrs. Mary Demarest, Henry L. Dickman, William Garvin, Phillip Payne, Edward Schwartz and Frank Caprio—and assailed them bitterly.

He scathingly denounced the arrest of Mrs. Hall at her home last July at midnight, with reporters and photographers present. He asked why the officers could not have waited until the next morning, instead of arousing her out of bed.

Gentle Willie Stevens.

"And gentle Willie Stevens, who never injured a bird," continued McCarter, "was kidnapped and subjected to a thirty-third degree all night in the presence of officers and photographers—and all they could get was an innocent man's story."

Simpson's imputation against Willie Stevens' parentage was assailed by McCarter with fiery energy.

"If his statement had been made south of the Mason and Dixon line, he would have been knocked down," declared McCarter.

PORTLAND MART TREND IS LOWER

Fresh Egg Values Weakening—Dairy Quotations 1c to 2c Lower

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 2 (AP).—Fresh egg values are rapidly weakening under heavy production. The outstanding feature in the local market for the month just ended was the heavy receipts of fresh eggs. According to government reports, a total of 3,351 cases came in, as compared to 15,439 cases in October and 12,865 cases during November last year.

Quotations on the dairy exchange are 1 to 2 cents lower today. Extras and firsts eased off another cent at 44 and 42c respectively, while current receipts declined 2 cents to the 41c level.

The butter market has shown a little strength recently and that is reflected in the figures which show receipts of butter in November at 245,610 pounds in comparison with 292,453 pounds in October.

Standard cubes are a cent lower today on the dairy exchange at 41c. Receipts of surplus cubes from country creameries amounted to 15,241 pounds with the local make reported at 21,130 pounds. Withdrawals from storage were 3,212 pounds.

Country dressed meats were quiet today although there was a little better inquiry for top hogs at 16 to 16½c. Choice light veal generally around 15½ to 16c.

No interest is shown in the poultry market and receipts have likewise fallen off since the Thanksgiving rush. Items and springs are steady.

NEAR FLOOD NEAR MEDFORD

MEDFORD, Ore., Dec. 2 (AP).—Near flood conditions prevail today throughout the upper Rogue river valley, following a week of unprecedented rain, climaxed by a precipitation of .32 inches last night.

Two smaller bridges of the Ashland-Klamath Falls highway have been washed out, according to a report to the forest service this afternoon. A bridge over Bear creek near Central Point is seriously menaced by high water, and has been closed to traffic.

Rogue river is rising at the rate of five inches an hour, a terrific volume of water pouring down from the hills. The water is over the top of Gold Butte dam, 65 inches, according to measurements this noon. Every creek and stream in Jackson county is out of its banks and a raging torrent.

The prediction is for more rain and heavy showers fell this morning.
