The conference season will open here on Jan. 22, against the university of Idaho. At that time, the new \$125,000 basketball pavilion of the University of Oregon will be dedicated.

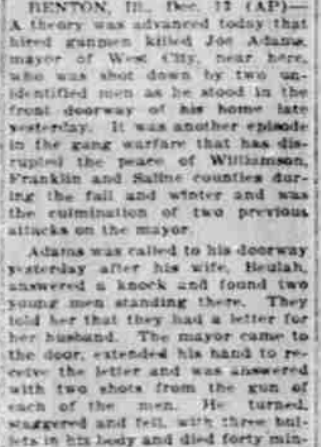

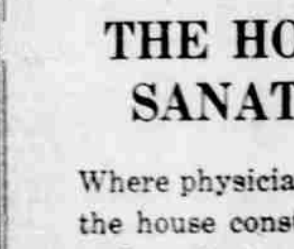
