LESS PUPILS IN IDAHO SCHOOLS

BOISE, Jan. 3.—Fewer Idaho children are going to high school these days, it is indicated in the biennial report of the state superintendent of public instruction, made public by Miss Elizabeth Hanson, retiring superintendent. Total enrollment in all schools in the year 1924-1925 was 117,965, compared with 117,569 in 1923-1924.

Total enrollment in elementary schools in 1925-1926 was 55,727, an increase of 59 over the 55,668 enrolled the previous year. In the high schools there were 22,228 pupils in 1924-1925, compared with 21,831 in 1923-1924. The number of teachers in all grades was 4333 in 1925 and 4276 in 1924.

Income from all sources for use in the schools was \$9,464,212.21 in 1925 and \$10,746,722.55 in 1924. Of this sum \$5,866,362.20 went to teachers' salaries in 1925, and \$5,174,212.55 in 1924. The cost of operating school systems for the term of 1924-1925 was \$25,374,872.

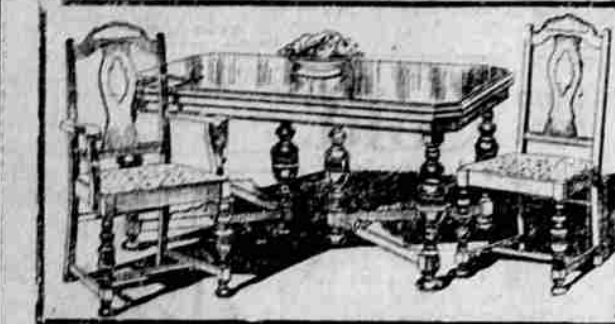

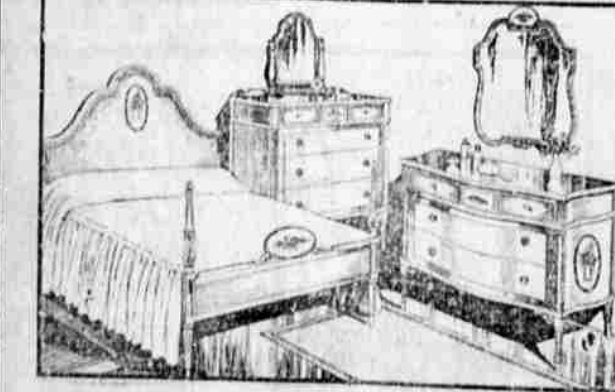
