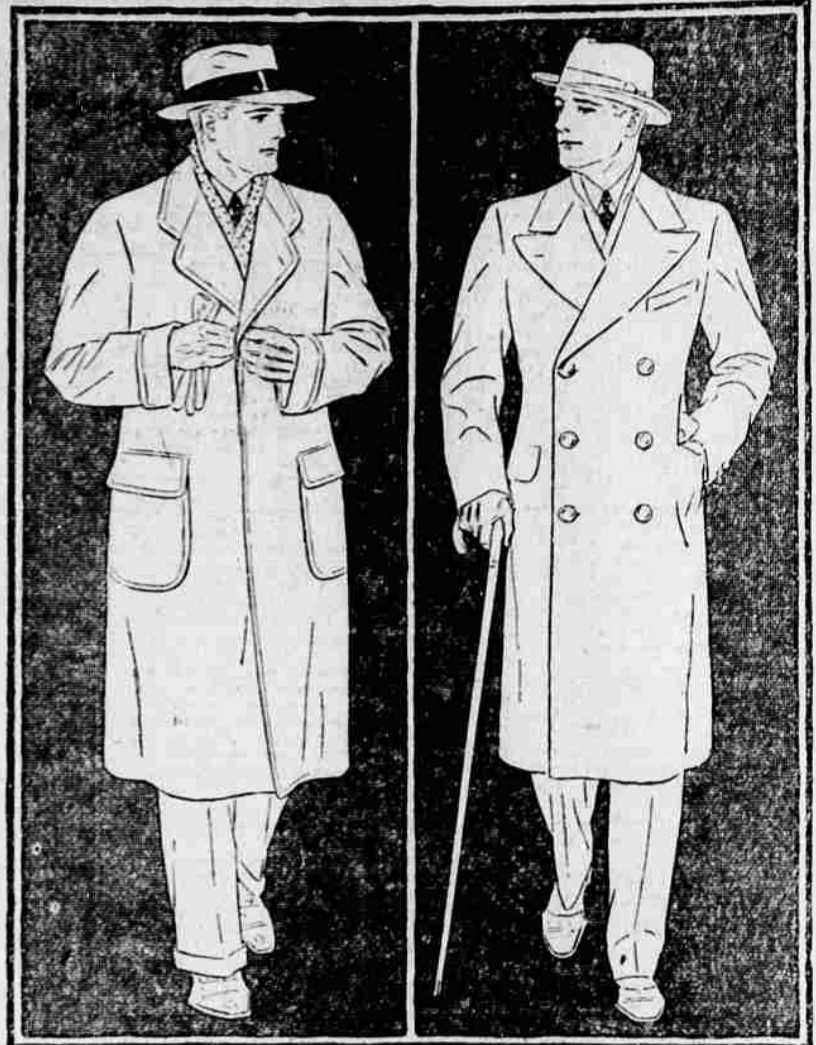

NEW YORK, Jan. 10. (AP)—Earl Carroll, theatrical producer, has his appeal today from a sentence of six months and a day in Al-
