YOUR INCOME TAX

Losses arising from "fires, storms, shipwreck, or other casualty, or from theft" are deductible and need not be connected with the taxpayer's trade or business. If his home or automobile is destroyed by fire, or his summer furniture damaged by storm, he may claim a deduction for the loss sustained. Allowance of course, must be made for any insurance received. The term "other casualty" within the meaning of the revenue act of 1926, is one arising through the physical force of nature—for example, a flood or frost.

Loss of property by theft or burglary is an allowable deduction, and need not be incurred in trade or business. Hence the loss sustained by the theft of jewelry or an automobile used for pleasure or convenience is deductible. Sound circumstances attending a loss of jewelry leave the owner in doubt as to whether it was stolen, misplaced, or lost from his person, a claim for loss would not be allowed. It must be established that the jewelry was stolen.

A loss for embezzlement is deductible for the year in which sustained. Losses in illegal transactions are not deductible. Legislation makes illegal many forms of wagering contracts. But if the laws of a state do not prohibit betting—as for example, at a race track—such transactions are lawful and the entire amount of the losses sustained may be deducted from gross income.
