Cloture Rule Invoked in Senate To Force Action on Prohi Measure

WASHINGTON, Feb. 28 (AP)—The cloture rule, limiting debate, was invoked by the senate today to force action on the prohibition and customs reorganization bill put forward by the administration. Assistant Secretary Andrews backed the measure, which also had the support of dry organizations. Some of the wetts in the senate also favored it, while others threatened a filibuster against it.
