

SCARLET FEVER WARNING ISSUED

A Very Contagious Disease, Health Board Secretary Declares

By Dr. Frederick Seiler, Health Board Secretary. The presence of the contagious disease of scarlet fever in this state, we think it advisable to again warn the people of the seriousness of the disease. No matter how mild a case may be, the complications arising therefrom may be serious. Scarlet fever is a very contagious disease, although a certain percent of children and a larger percent of adults exposed will escape contracting it. Although one may have a mild case it is no sign that the next one who may get sick may not have a severe case. This disease is spread chiefly by contact between one who is susceptible and one who has the disease or is carrying the infection. All cases of scarlet fever should be quarantined until the health officer states it is safe to mingle with others.

The measures necessary to control scarlet fever are early report, the isolation of cases, quarantine of susceptible persons who have been exposed, and inspection of school children. When school children develop this disease it is most important to keep them away from the children daily for the duration of infected cases. 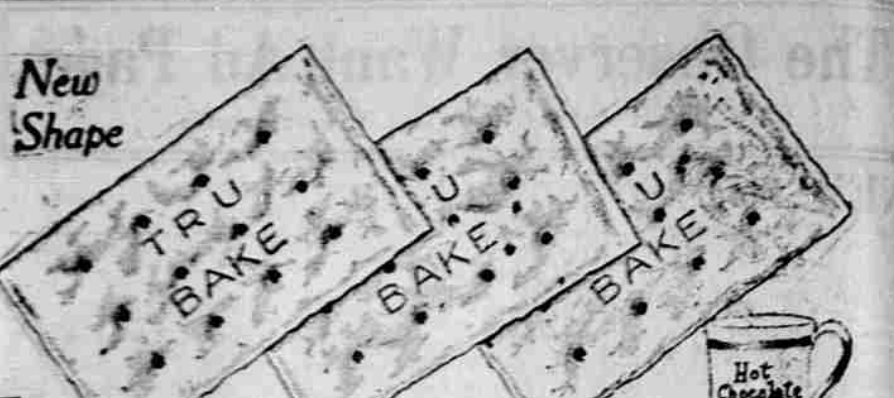
Beet Planting Will Be Small Near Caldwell

CALDWELL, Mar. 18.—Temporarily, at least, the white fly, bane of sugar beet growers, has won the fight for the field in this section. Tuesday it was said that no beets would be planted around here or in the wider district this season.

Last year, because of the drought and warm weather, was particularly favorable to development of the pest and few farmers who planted beet crops harvested any beets. In the Idaho Falls section there will be few beets this year, it was said, and minor Idaho beet growers, some of which were not operating last year, will center their operations in Utah, Colorado and other beet-producing states during 1927, it was asserted.

been associated. Over 40 per cent of the cases show a marked obesity before the outbreak of the disease. Perhaps a more careful history will show a greater percentage. Careful statistics of life insurance companies show that the most favorable weight for longevity in middle life is 10 to 20 pounds below the normal weight. The penalty, therefore, of overweight is increasing mortality and diabetes is the most potent factor. The greater the obesity, the more likely the penalty. While it happens, it is quite rare for diabetes to develop in a person habitually underweight.

The answer to these statements, from the standpoint of prevention, is to avoid excessive eating, to limit the intake of food to body needs rather than to caprice of the appetite. The more the indulgence in rich and sweet foods, the more the prevalence of overweight and diabetes.



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The United States, but a rough estimate based on mortality records would lead us to believe that two per cent of the population has diabetes, or that in this country more than 2,500,000 diabetics exist.

The increase in the number of cases discovered is probably due to several causes, such as greater accuracy of vital statistics, more frequent urinary examinations, a general increase in the duration of life, and the increasing number of physical examinations by family physicians.

In New York City, the total mortality per thousand population has been halved in the last 40 years, but the diabetic death rate has increased six fold. The registrar's office in Boston shows that between 1895 and 1915 the average duration of life in the fatal cases of diabetes amounted to 2 1/2 years. In 1915 it was 4 1/2 years, and in 1920 it was 5 1/2 years. This shows an increase of about three years in the life expectancy of the diabetic, and the 2,500,000 cases in this country get an additional 6,000,000 years of life.

It is found that more men than women are treated for diabetes with a greater mortality among the women. This is due probably to the discovery of a greater number of cases in men who take life insurance examinations, and the difference of women for physical examinations.

Heredity plays an important part and should be given serious attention by all families where diabetes is known to exist. The Jewish race, with a special tendency, is prone to the disease. The physical causes of diabetes are unknown. Possibly infections, localized in some spot such as the teeth, tonsils and sinuses, and gastric ulcer, gall-bladder disease, acute appendicitis, and chronic
