MENUS

By Sister Mary BREAKFAST - Stewed prunes, cereal, cream, poached eggs on milk toast, crisp broiled bacon, milk, coffee.

LUNCHEON - Tuna in a hole, scalloped tomatoes, raisin bread, vanilla cookies, milk, tea.

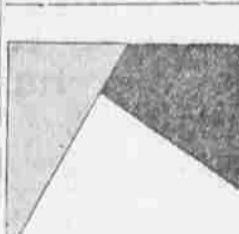
DINNER - Stuffed steak, potatoes au gratin, buttered spinach, banana and peanut salad, tapioca cream with strawberries, milk, coffee.

Tuna in a hole is an old English dish that is really very good despite its name. The oldest recipe added suet to the batter which makes a party-like crust. However, for general use in a family with children the less rich dish is more desirable.

Two cups chopped (not put through food chopper) lamb, 1 cup milk, 1/2 cup flour, 1 egg, 1/2 cup flour, 1 egg, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1 teaspoon melted butter.

The meat is cooked or raw. If raw more time must be allowed in baking. Cut meat in half-inch dice or chop coarsely in chopping bowl. Put into a well-buttered baking dish and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Mix and sift flour and salt. Slowly add milk, stirring to keep smooth. Add egg well beaten and melted butter. Beat hard with egg beater for two minutes and pour over meat. Bake 20 minutes in a hot oven until well puffed and firm. Reduce heat and bake slowly until meat is done. The English way to do it is to "cut in squares and serve overlapping each other on a hot dish" but we serve it from the baking dish.

Bricklayers who were "made" on the grounds, the bricks were manufactured in the prison kilns and most of the lumber was saved and trimmed by the convicts. A MEDICAL ASPECT OF COLLEGE SUICIDES

Member Georgia Memorial Inst. The increasing number of suicides in our colleges gives us cause to pause a moment and wonder what is really the underlying reason for this self destruction.

In my college days we never heard of a member of the student body possessing the desire to take his own life.

They were commonly tried to make men and women out of us "book learnin'" was a secondary consideration. They knew what some of the instructors of the colleges today seem not to know, that the things written in the books would seem to be forgotten, and that the essential thing was that we should obtain the proper ideas of life.

There seems to be a different notion in many schools, now-a-days. I may "seem" because the very schools which give the impression may well deny its presence. My children, at any rate, are obsessed with the idea that they must know the things that are written in the books at all costs.

Of course I would not have them neglect their lessons; but when a system requires the loss of sleep and the exhaustion of the principal energies, then too much importance is being given to "book learnin'."

In the "golden days" in college we were instructed by our parents to seek some good doctor in the community and have him look after our physical bodies. The college doctor is just as important to the schools as the family doctor is to the modern family, and neither of them should ever be eliminated.

Every college should have a physician for every 500 students, and members of the faculty should listen to his advice in regard to the students, for whom he should make a regular twice-yearly physical examination.

Special attention be given the physical condition of the students, and if the faculty of the college will return just a little to the method of trying to make men and women instead of turning out "swollen encyclopedia's," and if they will come into more personal contact with the student body, and take the kind of interest in the students that they would take in their own children, the present wave of suicides in our colleges would not only be eliminated but the graduates would be better able to cope with the complexity of our present day civilization.

BEAN WEATHER IS HERE

Bean weather is warm weather, and while the promise of the calendar isn't always carried out in fulfilling the warm weather that the date would lead us to expect, cold spells are not of long duration. It is best not to plant the beans during one of these late cold spells. Put them into the ground when it is warm, soaking them until they are well swelled as a starter.

Try a few hills of pole beans this year as labor savers. Poles will give double the crop in half the space of dwarf beans. The Kentucky Wonders will be wonders if you have never grown them. Try them on a south porch as a vine.

If there isn't any space handy and enjoy the novelty of picking beans from the back porch. Pole beans are much more certain to give liberal crops than bush types. Plant the poles for both spring and fall beans when the beans are planted. The poles will then be planted firmly in the ground and waiting for the beans to take hold. Trying to put them in later is likely to injure the plants' root systems. Young chicks, especially those confined in brooders, peck at feed stuck to the feet and thus wound the skin. The taste of blood causes them to continue pecking at the toes of the victim and to attack other chicks. To stop this practice remove all wounded birds as soon as observed and isolate them until recovered. Keep the chicks occupied in jumping to reach vegetables and bones with streaks of meat attached suspended slightly above their heads.
