30,000 Children Killed in Highway Accidents During Five-Year Period

WASHINGTON, June 11—Thirty thousand school children, most of them under 12 years of age, were killed on the highways during the five year period ending January 1, 1927, the American Road Builders' association stated recently.

OILING CREWS IN STATE AT WORK

Nine Gangs Start Operations on Macadam Highways of Oregon

Nine state oiling crews are at work on macadam highways of Oregon and to save motorists of the presence of fresh oil the Oregon State Motor association has issued a bulletin giving the location of the operations.

Macadam highways, treated with oil, have stood the test of travel and Oregon's roads are being held up to the rest of the nation as a model of what can be done to maintain permanently a macadam pavement.

With the idea of serving the motorists and issuing information that may cause persons to change their plans so as to avoid the freshly oiled stretches, the motor club will issue these bulletins regularly.

Gasoline Taxes In Oregon For April \$310,000

SALEM, Ore., June 11 (AP)—Taxes collected on gasoline and distillate sales in Oregon during the month of April 1927, amounted to \$310,655.11 according to a statement made by Secretary of State Roger. Dealer reported aggregate sales of 9,788,145 gallons of gasoline, and 650,421 gallons of distillate. As compared with April 1926, gasoline purchases increased more than 11 per cent and the use of distillate increased nearly 21 per cent.

ONE SECTION COMPLETE

BEND, Ore., June 11—The Bend-Redmond road, closed for oiling work during the past few days, will be opened to traffic all day Sunday for the benefit of holiday travelers. It was announced at the highway office here today by C. W. Wanser, division engineer.

Monday morning oiling work will begin north of the Plainview road, traffic being detoured from this point into Redmond. The Bend-Sisters road, which has received its second coat of light oil, is still closed to traffic, Wanser said.

The snow plow working on the McKenzie highway above Windy point cleared three-fourths of a mile of road yesterday, Wanser said. This snow banks ranged from four to five feet in depth and in many places it was necessary for the big plow to back out of the drifts and back into the snow again after a fresh start.

Chicago (AP)—Price wars have made travel cheap for thousands of motor coach line patrons in the middle west. Bus lines from Chicago and Detroit have become so numerous that many have resorted to rate-slashing in which fares have fallen to \$2.50 for the Detroit-Chicago trip—less than a cent a mile for the ten-hour journey and only a quarter of the rail fare.

Price Wars Have Made Auto Stage Travel Cheaper

Long haul rates have been cut proportionately with bus travel between Chicago and Los Angeles as low as \$35. Competition for Detroit-Toldeo travel reduced the \$1.50 rate for a one-way trip finally to 45 cents.

Officials regard price-cutting as temporary, and some say profit can be made even at the low rates if buses are filled to capacity of about 25 persons. Regulatory laws add to the expense, however, an example being a Michigan rule requiring each bus to have two licensed drivers on duty at the same time.

Supply Company Will Move Into Men's Wear Store

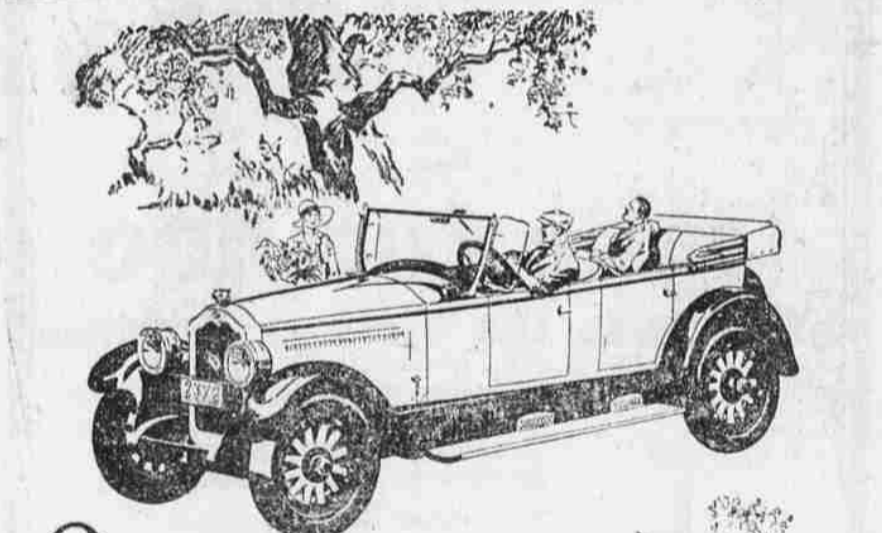
