Membership In Churches on The Increase in U.S.

CHICAGO, June 18.—If the progress of the church census according to the country, recent statistics reveal that we are getting better. To 1925 there was an increase of 489,000 members. This was the smallest gain for a number of years, but there was a large increase of 470,000 in 1926. The Catholics had a gain of 147,257 and the entire Protestant gain was 341,743. The Methodist made the largest gain of any Protestant church, the Baptist next and the Presbyterian third.

WINNINGS

With a membership of 16,304,171 the Catholic church, Roman Catholic and Old, added 147,257; the Methodists, 15 bodies with 4,006,288 members gained 48,008; the Baptists, 14 bodies, with 3,670,897 members gained 66,922; the Presbyterians, 9 bodies, with 2,619,716 members gained 48,779; the Lutherans, 26 bodies, with 2,588,279 members gained 12,152; the Disciples of Christ, 2 bodies, with 2,754,512 members decreased 1887; Eastern Orthodox, 8 bodies with 751,880 members increased 22,250; Eastern Day schools, 2 bodies, with 539,382 members increased 18,522; Episcopal, 3 bodies, with 243,924 members gained 6327; United Brethren in Christ, 2 bodies, with 496,031 members decreased 1225; Brethren (Dunkards), 4 bodies, with 154,788 members increased 6681; Adventists, 5 bodies, with 1,089,891 members increased 1789; Plymouth, 4 bodies, with 1,134,122 members decreased 75; Miscellaneous, 12 bodies, with 90,819 members, increased 4672.

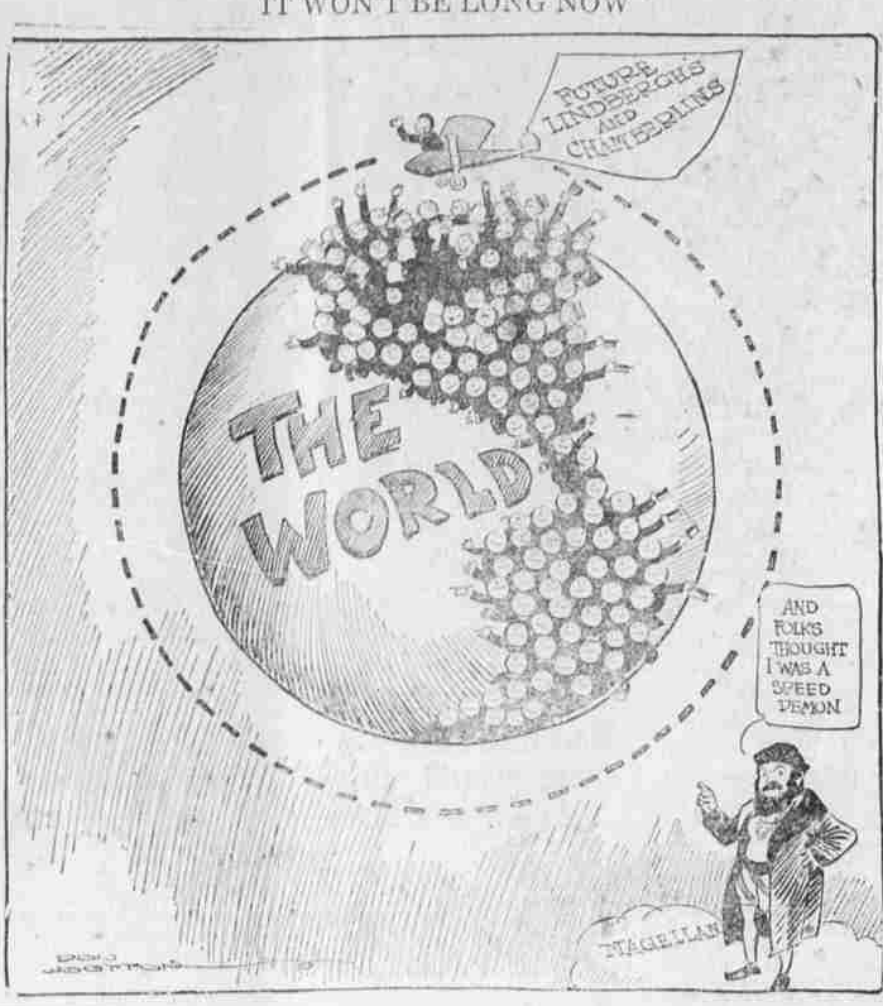

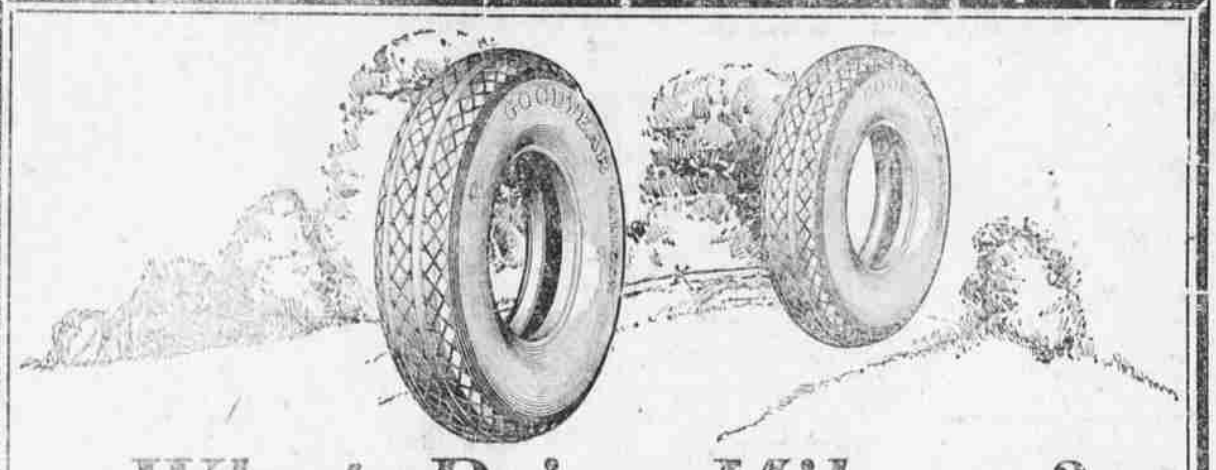
