**Farm Pointers**  
Second growth white ash and hickory in the central states hardwood region frequently bring \$25 to \$40 per thousand board feet on the stump. Farm woodlands are worth taking care of, just as the other farm crops are.

Whenever possible, stable manure should be handled directly to the field and spread at once. When this is not feasible a covered storage pit or bin may be provided at a distance from the stable and milk house. Such treatment of manure not only is a health measure, but it is an economy in farm practice. It reduces waste of valuable fertilizing materials.

A good-looking cow may not always be the best producer. In judging dairy cattle it is well first to fix clearly in mind the points regarded as most closely associated with milk production, namely, dairy temperament, body capacity, and mammary system. General appearance, type, size and condition are closely related to the so-called fancy points, pretty head, level rump, small horns, straight back, and well-balanced udder. While these points are slightly, if at all, correlated with producing ability, they enhance the animal's selling value.

It is useless in the long run and wasteful to advertise a product of which there is not a dependable supply at all times, or to advertise a product that does not come up to the advertised description and being dissatisfaction to the consumer.

It is essential to provide sufficient rooming and floor space for hens, so they will be comfortable at night and exercise freely during the day. A plain, shed-roof house with openings in front and rear, according to climatic conditions, is well adapted for any section of the country.

Rainier National Park Will Open Season June 28

TACOMA, WASH., June 22—Rainier national park will officially open its gates to the touring public June 25, for the 25th annual season. Park officials have announced. All park hotels, camps, transportation and guide facilities will then be in full operation.

Travel records are expected to be smashed during the new season, when it is predicted in excess of 200,000 tourists will visit the park during the summer. Visitors from Oregon during the 1926 season numbered 6,958 people in 1,885 cars, ranking second among states other than Washington, in number of visitors.

A completely paved boulevard, seven or seven miles of well-paved highway now stretches the entire distance of 96 miles from Seattle and 55 miles from Tacoma to the national park entrance. Roads within the park are also reported in excellent condition. Seasonally, officials say, the park
